HELPS Word-studies

4352 *proskynéō* (from **4314** /*prós*, "towards" and *kyneo*, "to kiss") – properly, to kiss the ground when prostrating before a superior; to *worship*, ready "to fall down/prostrate oneself to adore on one's knees" (*DNTT*); to "do obeisance" (*BAGD*).

[“The basic meaning of **4352** (*proskynéō*), in the opinion of most scholars, is to *kiss*. . . . On Egyptian reliefs worshipers are represented

with outstretched hand throwing a kiss to (*pros-*) the deity" (*DNTT*, 2, 875,876).

4352 (*proskyneō*) has been (metaphorically) described as "the kissing-ground" between believers (the Bride) and Christ (the heavenly Bridegroom). While this is true, [4352](#) (*proskyneō*) suggests the willingness to make all necessary physical *gestures of obeisance*.]
