14. Baptized In The Name Of

God

And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved. **Acts 2:21**

Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost. **Acts 2:38**

Holy Spirit

Go you therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: **Matthew 28:19**

15. The Throne Of God

God

1 After this I looked, and, behold, a door was opened in heaven: and the first voice which I heard was as it were of a trumpet talking with me; which said, Come up hither, and I will show you things which must be hereafter. **2** And immediately I was in the spirit; and, behold, a throne was set in heaven, and one sat on the throne. **3** And he that sat was to look upon like a jasper and a sardine stone: and there was a rainbow round about the throne, in sight like unto an emerald. **4** And round about the throne were four and twenty seats: and upon the seats I saw four and twenty elders sitting, clothed in white raiment; and they had on their heads crowns of gold. **5** And out of the throne proceeded lightning and thundering and voices: and there were seven lamps of fire burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God. **6** And before the throne there was a sea of glass like unto crystal: and in the midst of the throne, and round about the throne, were four beasts full of eyes before and behind. **7** And the first beast was like a lion, and the second beast like a calf, and the third beast had a face as a man, and the fourth beast was like a flying eagle. **8** And the four beasts had each of them six wings about him; and they were full of eyes within: and they rest not day and night, saying, Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, which was, and is, and is to come. **9** And when those beasts give glory and honor and thanks to him that sat on the throne, who lives for ever and ever, **10** The four and twenty elders fall down before him that sat on the throne, and worship him that lives for ever and ever, and cast their crowns before the throne, saying, **11** Thou art worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power: for you has created all things, and for thy pleasure they are and were create **Revelation 4:1-11**

And cried with a loud voice, saying, Salvation to our God which sits upon the throne, and unto the Lamb. **Revelation 7:10**

Jesus

And I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth. **Revelation 5:6**

For the Lamb which is in the midst of the throne shall feed them, and shall lead them unto living fountains of waters: and God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes. **Revelation 7:17**

Holy Spirit

Thou art worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power: for you has created all things, and for thy pleasure they are and were created. **Revelation 4:11 (Genesis 1:2)**

16. Pray To

God

After this manner therefore pray you: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. **Matthew 6:9**

Jesus

59 And they stoned Stephen, calling upon God, and saying, Lord Jesus, receive my spirit. **60** And he kneeled down, and cried with a loud voice, Lord, lay not this sin to their charge. And when he had said this, he fell asleep. **Acts 7:59-60**

16 (For as yet he was fallen upon none of them: only they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus.) **24** Then answered Simon, and said, Pray you to the Lord for me, that none of these things which you have spoken come upon me. **Acts 8:16, 24**

Unto the church of God which is at Corinth, to them that are sanctified in Christ Jesus, called to be saints, with all that in every place call upon the name of Jesus Christ our Lord, both theirs and ours: **1 Corinthians 1:2**

8 For this thing I besought the Lord thrice, that it might depart from me. **9** And he said unto me, My grace is sufficient for you: for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me. **2 Corinthians 12:8-9**

13 These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that you may know that you have eternal life, and that you may believe on the name of the Son of God. **14** And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we ask any thing according to his will, he hears us: **15** And if we know that he hear us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of him. **1 John 5:13-15**

17. Redeemer

God

Who redeems your life from destruction; who crowns you with loving kindness and tender mercies; **Psalm 103:4**

7 Let Israel hope in the LORD: for with the LORD there is mercy, and with him is plenteous redemption. **8** And he shall redeem Israel from all his iniquities. **Psalm 130:7-8**

Thus said the LORD, your Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel; I am the LORD your God which teaches you to profit, which leads you by the way that you should go. **Isaiah 48:17**

For your Maker is your husband; the LORD of hosts is his name; and your Redeemer the Holy One of Israel; The God of the whole earth shall he be called. **Isaiah 54:5**

And they said, So do, as you has said. **18:6** And Abraham hastened into the tent unto Sarah, and said, Make ready quickly three measures of fine meal, knead it, and make cakes upon the hearth. **18:7** And Abraham ran unto the herd, and fetched a calf tender and good, and gave it unto a young man; and he hasted to dress it. **18:8** And he took butter, and milk, and the calf which he had dressed, and set it before them; and he stood by them under the tree, and they did eat. **18:9** And they said unto him, Where is Sarah your wife? And he said, Behold, in the tent. **18:10** And he said, I will certainly return unto you according to the time of life; and, lo, Sarah your wife shall have a son. And Sarah heard it in the tent door, which was behind him. **18:11** Now Abraham and Sarah were old and well stricken in age; and it ceased to be with Sarah after the manner of women. **18:12** Therefore Sarah laughed within herself, saying, After I am waxed old shall I have pleasure, my lord being old also? **18:13** And the LORD said unto Abraham, Wherefore did Sarah laugh, saying, Shall I of a surety bear a child, which am old? **18:14** Is any thing too hard for the LORD? At the time appointed I will return unto you, according to the time of life, and Sarah shall have a son. **18:15** Then Sarah denied, saying, I laughed not; for she was afraid. Peradventure there be fifty righteous within the city: wilt you also destroy and not spare the place for the fifty righteous that are therein? **18:25** That be far from you to do after this manner, to slay the righteous with the wicked: and that the righteous should be as the wicked, that be far from you: Shall not the Judge of all the earth do right? **18:26** And the LORD said, If I find in Sodom fifty righteous within the city, then I will spare all the place for their sakes. **18:27** And Abraham answered and said, Behold now, I have taken upon me to speak unto the Lord, which am but dust and ashes: **18:28** Peradventure there shall lack five of the fifty righteous: wilt you destroy all the city for lack of five? And he said, If I find there forty and five, I will not destroy it. **18:29** And he spoke unto him yet again, and said, Peradventure there shall be forty found there. And he said, I will not do it for forty's sake. **18:30** And he said unto him, Oh let not the Lord be angry, and I will speak: Peradventure there shall thirty be found there. And he said, I will not do it, if I find thirty there. **18:31** And he said, Behold now, I have taken upon me to speak unto the Lord: Peradventure there shall be twenty found there. And he said, I will not destroy it for twenty's sake. **18:32** And he said, Oh let not the Lord be angry, and I will speak yet but this once: Peradventure ten shall be found there. And he said, I will not destroy it for ten's sake. **18:33** And the LORD went his way, as soon as he had left communing with Abraham: and Abraham returned unto his place. **Genesis 18:1-33**

9 Then went up Moses, and Aaron, Nadab, and Abihu, and seventy of the elders of Israel: **10** And they saw the God of Israel: and there was under his feet as it were a paved work of a sapphire stone, and as it were the body of heaven in his clearness. **11** And upon the nobles of the children of Israel he laid not his hand: also they saw God, and did eat and drink. **Exodus 24:9-11**

Lord of Hosts

Much more then, being now justified by his blood, we shall be saved from wrath through him. **Romans 5:9**

19 To wit, that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and has committed unto us the word of reconciliation. **20** Now then we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God did beseech you by us: we pray you in Christ's stead, be you reconciled to God. **21** For he has made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him. **2 Corinthians 5:19-21**

Holy Spirit

And such were some of you: but you are washed, but you are sanctified, but you are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God. **1 Corinthians 6:11**

For we through the Spirit wait for the hope of righteousness by faith. **Galatians 5:5**

Even as David also describes the blessedness of the man, unto whom God imputes righteousness without works, **Romans 4:6**

Jude, the servant of Jesus Christ, and brother of James, to them that are sanctified by God the Father, and preserved in Jesus Christ, and called: **Jude 1:1**

Who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works. **Titus 2:14**

Holy Spirit

Elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, through sanctification of the Spirit, unto obedience and sprinkling of the blood of Jesus Christ: Grace unto you, and peace, be multiplied. **1 Peter 1:2**

God

Speak you also unto the children of Israel, saying, Verily my Sabbaths you shall keep: for it is a sign between me and you throughout your generations; that you may know that I am the LORD that does sanctify you. **Exodus 31:13**

48. Who Propitiates Our Sins?

Father

And Jesus answered and said unto him, Get you behind me, Satan: for it is written, Thou shall worship the Lord thy God, and him only shall you serve. **Luke 4:8**

20 Our fathers worshipped in this mountain; and you say, that in Jerusalem is the place where men ought to worship. **21** Jesus said unto her, Woman, believe me, the hour comes, when you shall neither in this mountain, nor yet at Jerusalem, worship the Father. **22** You worship you know not what: we know what we worship: for salvation is of the Jews. **23** But the hour comes, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeks such to worship him. **24** God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth. **John 4:20-24**

And thus are the secrets of his heart made manifest; and so falling down on his face he will worship God, and report that God is in you of a truth. **1 Corinthians 14:25**

The four and twenty elders fall down before him that sat on the throne, and worship him that lives for ever and ever, and cast their crowns before the throne, saying. **Revelation 4:10**

And the four beasts said, Amen. And the four and twenty elders fell down and worshipped him that lives for ever and ever. **Revelation 5:14**

And all the angels stood round about the throne, and about the elders and the four beasts, and fell before the throne on their faces, and worshipped God, **Revelation 7:11**

And the four and twenty elders, which sat before God on their seats, fell upon their faces, and worshipped God, **Revelation 11:16**

Saying with a loud voice, Fear God, and give glory to him; for the hour of his judgment is come: and worship him that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters. **Revelation 14:7**

Who shall not fear you, O Lord, and glorify thy name? for you only art holy: for all nations shall come and worship before you; for thy judgments are made manifest. **Revelation 15:4**

And the four and twenty elders and the four beasts fell down and worshipped God that sat on the throne, saying, Amen; Alleluia. **Revelation 19:4**

And I fell at his feet to worship him. And he said unto me, See you do it not: I am thy fellow servant, and of thy brethren that have the testimony of Jesus: worship God: for the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy. **Revelation 19:10**

Then said he unto me, See you do it not: for I am thy fellow servant, and of thy brethren the prophets, and of them which keep the sayings of this book: worship God. **Revelation 22:9**

Idolatrous Worship Repudiated

9 And said unto him, All these things will I give you, if you wilt fall down and worship me. **10** Then said Jesus unto him, Get you hence, Satan: for it is written, Thou shall worship the Lord thy God, and him only shall you serve. **Matthew 4:9-10**

7 If you therefore wilt worship me, all shall be your. **8** And Jesus answered and said unto him, Get you behind me, Satan: for it is written, Thou shall worship the Lord thy God, and him only shall you serve. **Luke 4:7-8**

Yea, you took up the tabernacle of Moloch, and the star of your god Remphan, figures which you made to worship them: and I will carry you away beyond Babylon. **Acts 7:43**

25 And as Peter was coming in, Cornelius met him, and fell down at his feet, and worshipped him. **26** But Peter took him up, saying, Stand up; I myself also am a man. **Acts 10:25-26**

And the rest of the men which were not killed by these plagues yet repented not of the works of their hands, that they should not

worship devils, and idols of gold, and silver, and brass, and stone, and of wood: which neither can see, nor hear, nor walk: **Revelation 9:20**

4 And they worshipped the dragon which gave power unto the beast: and they worshipped the beast, saying, Who is like unto the beast? who is able to make war with him? **8** And all that dwell upon the earth shall worship him, whose names are not written in the book of life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world. **Revelation 13:4, 8**

12 And he exercises all the power of the first beast before him, and causes the earth and them which dwell therein to worship the first beast, whose deadly wound was healed. **15** And he had power to give life unto the image of the beast, that the image of the beast should both speak, and cause that as many as would not worship the image of the beast should be killed. **Revelation 13:12, 15**

9 And the third angel followed them, saying with a loud voice, If any man worship the beast and his image, and receive his mark in his forehead, or in his hand, **11** And the smoke of their torment ascends up for ever and ever: and they have no rest day nor night, who worship the beast and his image, and whosoever receives the mark of his name. **Revelation 14:9, 11**

And the first went, and poured out his vial upon the earth; and there fell a noisome and grievous sore upon the men which had the mark of the beast, and upon them which worshipped his image. **Revelation 16:2**

And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshipped his image. These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone. **Revelation 19:20**

And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them: and I saw the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus, and for the word of God, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received his mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years. **Revelation 20:4**

And I fell at his feet to worship him. And he said unto me, See you do it not: I am thy fellow servant, and of thy brethren that have the testimony of Jesus: worship God: for the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy. **Revelation 19:10**

8 And I John saw these things, and heard them. And when I had heard and seen, I fell down to worship before the feet of the angel which showed me these things. **9** Then said he unto me, See you do it not: for I am thy fellow servant, and of thy brethren the prophets, and of them which keep the sayings of this book: worship God. **Revelation 22:8-9**

Worshipped Offered to Christ

2 Saying, Where is he that is born King of the Jews? for we have seen his star in the east, and are come to worship him. **8** And he sent them to Bethlehem, and said, Go and search diligently for the young child; and when you have found him, bring me word again, that I may come and worship him also. **11** And when they were come into the house, they saw the young child with Mary his mother, and fell down, and worshipped him: and when they had opened their treasures, they presented unto him gifts; gold, and frankincense, and myrrh. **Matthew 2:2, 8, 11**

And, behold, there came a leper and worshipped him, saying, Lord, if you wilt, you canst make me clean. **Matthew 8:2**

While he spoke these things unto them, behold, there came a certain ruler, and worshipped him, saying, My daughter is even now dead: but come and lay thy hand upon her, and she shall live. **Matthew 9:18**

Then they that were in the ship came and worshipped him, saying, Of a truth you art the Son of God. **Matthew 14:33**

Then came she and worshipped him, saying, Lord, help me. **Matthew 15:25**

Then came to him the mother of Zebedee's children with her sons, worshipping him, and desiring a certain thing of him. **Matthew 20:20**

And as they went to tell his disciples, behold, Jesus met them, saying, All hail. And they came and held him by the feet, and worshipped him. **Matthew 28:9**

And when they saw him, they worshipped him: but some doubted. **Matthew 28:17**

And they worshipped him, and returned to Jerusalem with great joy: **Luke 24:52**

And he said, Lord, I believe. And he worshipped him. **John 9:38**

And again, when he brings in the first begotten into the world, he said, And let all the angels of God worship him. **Hebrews 1:6**

Worship Offered in Mockery

But when he saw Jesus afar off, he ran and worshipped him, **Mark 5:6**

And they smote him on the head with a reed, and did spit upon him, and bowing their knees worshipped him. **Mark 15:19**

Worshipping Man

The servant therefore fell down, and worshipped him, saying, Lord, have patience with me, and I will pay you all. **Matthew 18:26**

Behold, I will make them of the synagogue of Satan, which say they are Jews, and are not, but do lie; behold, I will make them to come and worship before thy feet, and to know that I have loved you. **Revelation 3:9**

51. Pray To Jesus

Come unto me, all you that labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. **Matthew 11:28**

And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved. **Acts 2:21**

And they stoned Stephen, calling upon God, and saying, Lord Jesus, receive my spirit. **Acts 7:59**

14 And here he has authority from the chief priests to bind all that call on thy name. **21** But all that heard him were amazed, and said; Is not this he that destroyed them which called on this name in Jerusalem, and came hither for that intent, that he might bring them bound unto the chief priests? **Acts 9:14, 21**

And now why tarry you? Arise, and be baptized, and wash away thy sins, calling on the name of the Lord. **Acts 22:16**

For there is no difference between the Jew and the Greek: for the same Lord over all is rich unto all that call upon him. **Romans 10:12**

Unto the church of God which is at Corinth, to them that are sanctified in Christ Jesus, called to be saints, with all that in every place call upon the name of Jesus Christ our Lord, both theirs and ours: **1 Corinthians 1:2**

8 For this thing I besought the Lord thrice, that it might depart from me. **9** And he said unto me, My grace is sufficient for you: for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me. **2 Corinthians 12:8-9**

9 Wherefore God also has highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name: **10** That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth; **11** And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. **Philippians 2:9-11**

Flee also youthful lusts: but follow righteousness, faith, charity, peace, with them that call on the Lord out of a pure heart. **2 Timothy 2:22**
