1. Who was the first person to attain immortality?

And **Enoch** walked with God: and he was not; for God took him. [Genesis 5:24](#).

By faith **Enoch** was translated that he should not see death; and was not found, because God had translated him: for before his translation he had this testimony, that he pleased God. [Hebrews 11:5](#).

2. Who was the second?

1 And after six days Jesus took Peter, James, and John his brother, and brings them up into an high mountain apart, **2** And was transfigured before them: and his face did shine as the sun, and his raiment was white as the light. **3** And, behold, there appeared unto them **Moses** and **Elijah** talking with him. [Matthew 17:1-3](#).

3. Who was the third?

And it came to pass, as they still went on, and talked, that, behold, there appeared a chariot of fire, and horses of fire, and parted them both asunder; and **Elijah** went up by a whirlwind into heaven. [2 Kings 2:11](#).

4. Is man mortal or immortal by nature?

Shall mortal man be more just than God? Shall a man be more pure than his maker? [Job 4:17-21](#).

5. Where does man stay prior to the Second Coming of Christ?

O that you would hide me in the grave, that you would keep me secret, until your wrath be past, that you would appoint me a set time, and remember me! [Job 14:13](#).

6. Who is the source of life?

10 For you wilt not leave my soul in hell; neither wilt you suffer your Holy One to see corruption. **11** Thou wilt show me the path of life: in your presence is fullness of joy; at your right hand there are pleasures for evermore. [Psalm 16:10, 11](#).

He asked life of you, and you gave it him, even length of days for ever and ever. [Psalm 21:4](#).

The meek shall eat and be satisfied: they shall praise the LORD that seek him: your heart shall live for ever. [Psalm 22:26](#).

7. Where will the righteous spend eternity?

Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life: and I will dwell in the house of the LORD for ever. [Psalm 23:6](#).

8. Where must we look for eternal life?

Into your hand I commit my spirit: you has redeemed me, O LORD God of truth. [Psalm 31:5](#).

For with you is the fountain of life: in your light shall we see light. [Psalm 36:9](#).

9. What must we forsake to have eternal life?

18 The LORD knows the days of the upright: and their inheritance shall be for ever. **27** Depart from evil, and do good; and dwell for evermore. [Psalm 37:18, 27](#).

10. Is the soul immortal or in need of redemption?

7 None of them can by any means redeem his brother, nor give to God a ransom for him: **8** (For the redemption of their soul is precious, and it ceases for ever:) **9** That he should still live for ever, and not see corruption. [Psalm 49:7-9](#),

11. Who can redeem man form the grave?

14 Like sheep they are laid in the grave; death shall feed on them; and the upright shall have dominion over them in the morning; and their beauty shall consume in the grave from their dwelling. **15** But God will redeem my soul from the power of the grave: for he shall receive me. Selah. [Psalm 14, 15](#).

Preserve my soul; for I am holy: O you my God, save your servant that trusts in you. [Psalm 86:12](#).

As the dew of Hermon, and as the dew that descended upon the mountains of Zion: for there the LORD commanded the blessing, even life for evermore. [Psalm 133:3](#).

12. What will the redeemed sing in heaven?

1 David's Psalm of praise. I will extol you, my God, O king; and I will bless your name for ever and ever. **2** Every day will I bless you; and I will praise your name for ever and ever. [Proverbs 14:32](#).

13. What will happen to sin and death?

He will swallow up death in victory; and the Lord GOD will wipe away tears from off all faces; and the rebuke of his people shall he take away from off all the earth: for the LORD has spoken it. [Isaiah 25:8](#).

14. Will there be a resurrection form the grave?

Thy dead men shall live, together with my dead body shall they arise. Awake and sing, you that dwell in dust: for your dew is as the dew of herbs, and the earth shall cast out the dead. [Isaiah 26:19](#).

15. Is there any knowledge in the grave?

18 For the grave cannot praise you, death can not celebrate you: they that go down into the pit cannot hope for your truth. **19** The living, the living, he shall praise you, as I do this day: the father to the children shall make known your truth. [Isaiah 38:18, 19](#).

16. Will the wicked be resurrected also?

2 And many of them that sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, and some to shame and everlasting contempt. **3** And they that be wise shall shine as the brightness of the firmament; and they that turn many to righteousness as the stars for ever and ever. [Daniel 12:2, 3](#).

17. Will the soul die in hell or the body only?

And fear not them which kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul: but rather fear him which is able to destroy both soul and body in hell. [Matthew 10:28](#).

For what is a man profited, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul? or what shall a man give in exchange for his soul? [Matthew 16:26](#).

18. Have any people gone the heaven already?

1 And after six days Jesus took Peter, James, and John his brother, and brings them up into an high mountain apart, **2** And was transfigured before them: and his face did shine as the sun, and his raiment was white as the light. **3** And, behold, there appeared unto them Moses and Elijah talking with him. [Matthew 17:1-3](#).

19. What are some conditions for entering heaven?

16 And, behold, one came and said unto him, Good Master, what good thing shall I do, that I may have eternal life? **17** And he said unto him, Why call you me good? there is none good but one, that is, God: but if you wilt enter into life, keep the commandments. [Matthew 19:16, 17](#).

25 And, behold, a certain lawyer stood up, and tempted him, saying, Master, what shall I do to inherit eternal life? **26** He said unto him, What is written in the law? How reads you? **27** And he answering said, Thou shall love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy strength, and with all thy mind; and thy neighbour as thyself. **28** And he said unto him, Thou has answered right: this do, and you shall live. [Luke 10:25-28](#).

20. How many groups will rise from the grave?

And these shall go away into everlasting punishment: but the righteous into life eternal. [Matthew 25:46](#).

21. Does God promise man eternal life?

But he shall receive an hundredfold now in this time, houses, and brethren, and sisters, and mothers, and children, and lands, with persecutions; and in the world to come eternal life. [Mark 10:30](#).

26 And as touching the dead, that they rise: have you not read in the book of Moses, how in the bush God spoke unto him, saying, I am the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob? **27** He is not the God of the dead, but the **God of the living**: you therefore do greatly err. [Mark 12:26, 27](#).

22. Who comes with Jesus at the Second Coming?

25 For what is a man advantaged, if he gain the whole world, and lose himself, or be cast away? **26** For whosoever shall be ashamed of me and of my words, of him shall the Son of man be ashamed, when he shall come in his own glory, and in his Father's, and of the holy angels. [Luke 9:25-26](#).

23. Is there sex in heaven?

35 But they which shall be accounted worthy to obtain that world, and the resurrection from the dead, neither marry, nor are given in marriage: **36** Neither can they die any more: for they are equal unto the angels; and are the children of God, being the children of the resurrection. **37** Now that the dead are raised, even Moses showed at the bush, when he calls the Lord the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob. [Luke 20:36-38](#).

24. Who did God send to give eternal life?

14 And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of man be lifted up: **15** That whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have eternal life. **16** For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. **36** He that believeth on the Son has everlasting life: and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abides on him. [John 3:14-16, 36](#).

25. What book contains the answers?

Search the scriptures; for in them you think you have eternal life: and they are they which testify of me. [John 5:39](#).

26. When is this resurrection to happen?

39 And this is the Father's will which has sent me, that of all which he has given me I should lose nothing, but should raise it up again at the **last day**. **40** And this is the will of him that sent me, that every one which sees the Son, and believeth on him, may have everlasting life: and I will raise him up at the **last day**. **44** No man can come to me, except the Father which has sent me draw him: and I will raise him up at the **last day**. **47** Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me has **everlasting life**. **50** This is the bread which comes down from heaven, that a man may eat thereof, and not die. **51** I am the living bread which came down from heaven: if any man eat of this bread, he shall **live for ever**: and the bread that I will give is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world. **53** Then Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except you eat the flesh of the Son of man, and drink his blood, you have no life in you. [John 6:39, 40, 44, 47, 50, 51, 53](#),

27. Who gives this life?

And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand. [John 10:28](#).

25 Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live: **26** And whosoever lives and believeth in me shall never die. Believe you this? [John 11:25, 26](#).

Yet a little while, and the world sees me no more; but you see me: because I live, you shall live also. [John 14:19](#).

28. Who do we serve to obtain eternal life?

2 As you has given him power over all flesh, that he should give eternal life to as many as you has given him. **3** And this is life eternal, that they might know you the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom you has sent. [John 17:2, 3](#).

To them who by patient continuance in well doing seek for glory and honour and immortality, eternal life. [Romans 2:7](#).

22 But now being made free from sin, and become servants to God, you have your fruit unto holiness, and the end everlasting life. **23** For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord. [Romans 6:22, 23](#).

29. What happens at the resurrection?

51 Behold, I show you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, **52** In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed. **53** For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality. **54** So when this corruptible shall have put on incorruption, and this mortal shall have put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, Death is swallowed up in victory. **55** O death, where is thy sting? O grave, where is thy victory? [1 Corinthians 15:51-55](#).

30. What power must we have in us?

For he that sows to his flesh shall of the flesh reap corruption; but he that sows to the Spirit shall of the Spirit reap life everlasting. [Galatians 6:8](#).

31. Where is our hope laid up?

For the hope which is laid up for you in heaven, whereof you heard before in the word of the truth of the gospel; **6** Which is come unto you, as it is in all the world; and brings forth fruit, as it does also in you, since the day you heard of it, and knew the grace of God in truth. [Colossians 1:5, 6](#).

32. What does the Bible tell us about eternal life?

13 But I would not have you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning them which are asleep, that you sorrow not, even as others which have no hope. **14** For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so them also which sleep in Jesus will God bring with him. **15** For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that we which are alive and remain unto the coming of the Lord shall not prevent them which are asleep. **16** For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: **17** Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord. **18** Wherefore comfort one another with these words. [1 Thessalonians 4:13-18](#).

33. What happens to the wicked at the Second Coming?

7 And to you who are troubled rest with us, when the Lord Jesus shall be revealed from heaven with his mighty angels, **8** In flaming fire taking vengeance on them that know not God, and that obey not the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ: **9** Who shall be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord, and from the glory of his power. [2 Thessalonians 1:7-9](#).

34. Who is the source of Immortality?

15 Which in his times he shall show, who is the blessed and only Potentate, the King of kings, and Lord of lords; **16** Who only has immortality, dwelling in the light which no man can approach unto; whom no man has seen, nor can see: to whom be honor and power everlasting. Amen. [1 Timothy 6:15-16](#).

9 Who has saved us, and called us with an holy calling, not according to our works, but according to his own purpose and grace, which was given us in Christ Jesus before the world began, **10** But is now made manifest by the appearing of our Savior Jesus Christ, who has abolished death, and has brought life and immortality to light through the gospel. [2 Timothy 1:9, 10](#).

In hope of eternal life, which God, that cannot lie, promised before the world began. [Titus 1:2](#).

That being justified by his grace, we should be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life. [Titus 3:7](#).

And for this cause he is the mediator of the New Testament, that by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions that were under the first testament, they which are called might receive the promise of eternal inheritance. [Hebrews 9:15](#).

35. Whose resurrection saves us?

3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, which according to his abundant mercy has begotten us again unto a lively hope by the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, **4** To an inheritance incorruptible, and undefiled, and that fades not away, reserved in heaven for you, **5** Who are kept by the power of God through faith unto salvation ready to be revealed in the last time. [1 Peter 1:3-5](#).

17 And the world passed away, and the lust thereof: but he that does the will of God abides for ever. **25** And this is the promise that he has promised us, even eternal life. [1 John 2:17, 25](#).

These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that you may know that you have eternal life, and that you may believe on the name of the Son of God. [1 John 5:13](#).

Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life. [Jude 1:21](#).

36. How many people will see the Second Coming of Christ?

Behold, he comes with clouds; and every eye shall see him, and they also which pierced him: and all kingdoms of the earth shall wail because of him. Even so, Amen. [Revelation 1:7](#).

37. Where are the wicked sent at the Second Coming?

48 Which, when it was full, they drew to shore, and sat down, and gathered the good into vessels, but cast the bad away. **49** So shall it be at the end of the world: the angels shall come forth, and sever the wicked from among the just, **50** And shall cast them into the **furnace of fire**: there shall be wailing and gnashing of teeth. **Matthew 13:48-50**

And they went up on the breadth of the earth, and compassed the camp of the saints about, and the beloved city: and **fire** came down from God out of heaven, and devoured them. **Revelation 20:9**

38. What is the final fate of the wicked?

12 And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works. **13** And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works. **14** And death and hell were cast into **the lake of fire**. This is the **second death**. **15** And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire. **Revelation 20:12-15**

39. What food in heaven will we eat?

He that has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit said unto the churches; To him that overcomes will I give to eat of the tree of life, which is in the midst of the paradise of God. [Revelation 2:7](#).

40. How good will heaven be?

14 And I said unto him, Sir, you know. And he said to me, These are they which came out of great tribulation, and have washed their robes, and made them white in the blood of the Lamb. **15** Therefore are they before the throne of God, and serve him day and night in his temple: and he that sits on the throne shall dwell among them. **16** They shall hunger no more, neither thirst any more; neither shall the sun light on them, nor any heat. **17** For the Lamb which is in the midst of the throne shall feed them, and shall lead them unto living fountains of waters: and God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes. [Revelation 7:14-17](#).

3 And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, and be their God. **4** And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away. **5** And he that sat upon the throne said, Behold, I make all things new. And he said unto me, Write: for these words are true and faithful. **6** And he said unto me, It is done. I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end. I will give unto him that is athirst of the fountain of the water of life freely. [Revelation 21:3-6](#).
