Genesis

26:5 Because that Abraham obeyed my voice, and kept my charge, my commandments, my statutes, and my laws.

Exodus

15:26 And said, If you wilt diligently hearken to the voice of the LORD your God, and wilt do that which is right in his sight, and wilt give ear to his **commandments**, and keep all his statutes, I will put none of these diseases upon you, which I have brought upon the Egyptians: for I am the LORD that heals you.

16:28 And the LORD said unto Moses, How long refuse you to keep my commandments and my laws?

- 20:1 And God spoke all these words, saying,
- 20:2 I am the LORD your God, which have brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage.
- 20:3 Thou shall have no other gods before me.
- **20:4** Thou shall not make unto you any graven image, or any likeness of anything that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth:
- 20:5 Thou shall not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD your God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate me;
- 20:6 And showing mercy unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments.
- 20:7 Thou shall not take the name of the LORD your God in vain; for the LORD will not hold him guiltless that took his name in vain.
- 20:8 Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy.
- 20:9 Six days shall you labor, and do all your work:
- **20:10** But the seventh day is the Sabbath of the LORD your God: in it you shall not do any work, you, nor your son, nor your daughter, your manservant, nor your maidservant, nor your cattle, nor your stranger that is within your gates:
- 20:11 For in six days the LORD made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them is, and rested the seventh day: wherefore the LORD blessed the Sabbath day, and hallowed it.
- 20:12 Honor your father and your mother: that your days may be long upon the land which the LORD your God gives you.
- 20:13 Thou shall not kill.
- 20:14 Thou shall not commit adultery.
- 20:15 Thou shall not steal.
- 20:16 Thou shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.
- 20:17 Thou shall not covet your neighbor's house, you shall not covet your neighbor's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that is your neighbor's.
- **24:12** And the LORD said unto Moses, Come up to me into the mount, and be there: and I will give you tables of stone, and a **law**, and **commandments** which I have written; that you may teach them.
- **34:28** And he was there with the LORD forty days and forty nights; he did neither eat bread, nor drink water. And he wrote upon the tables the words of the covenant, the ten **commandments.**

Leviticus

- **4:2** Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, If a soul shall sin through ignorance against any of the **commandments** of the LORD concerning things which ought not to be done, and shall do against any of them.
- **4:13** And if the whole congregation of Israel sin through ignorance, and the thing be hid from the eyes of the assembly, and they have done somewhat against any of the **commandments** of the LORD concerning things which should not be done, and are guilty.

- **4:22** When a ruler has sinned, and done somewhat through ignorance against any of the **commandments** of the LORD his God concerning things which should not be done, and is guilty;
- **4:27** And if any one of the common people sin through ignorance, while he does somewhat against any of the **commandments** of the LORD concerning things which ought not to be done, and be guilty.
- **5:17** And if a soul sin, and commit any of these things which are forbidden to be done by the **commandments** of the LORD; though he knows it not, yet is he guilty, and shall bear his iniquity.
- 22:31 Therefore shall you keep my commandments, and do them: I am the LORD.
- 26:3 If you walk in my statutes, and keep my commandments, and do them.
- 26:14 But if you will not hearken unto me, and will not do all these commandments.
- **26:15** And if you shall despise my statutes, or if your soul abhor my judgments, so that you will not do all my **commandments**, but that you break my covenant.
- 27:34 These are the commandments, which the LORD commanded Moses for the children of Israel in mount Sinai.

Numbers

- 15:22 And if you have erred, and not observed all these commandments, which the LORD has spoken unto Moses.
- **15:39** And it shall be unto you for a fringe, that you may look upon it, and remember all the **commandments** of the LORD, and do them; and that you seek not after your own heart and your own eyes, after which you use to go a whoring:
- 15:40 That you may remember, and do all my commandments, and be holy unto your God.
- **36:13** These are the **commandments** and the judgments, which the LORD commanded by the hand of Moses unto the children of Israel in the plains of Moab by Jordan near Jericho.

Deuteronomy

- **4:2** You shall not add unto the word which I command you, neither shall you diminish ought from it, that you may keep the **commandments** of the LORD your God which I command you.
- **4:13** And he declared unto you his covenant, which he commanded you to perform, even ten **commandments**; and he wrote them upon two tables of stone.
- **4:40** Thou shall keep therefore his statutes, and his **commandments**, which I command you this day, that it may go well with you, and with your children after you, and that you may prolong your days upon the earth, which the LORD your God gives you, for ever.
- **5:10** And showing mercy unto thousands of them that love me and keep my **commandments**.
- **5:29** O that there were such an heart in them, that they would fear me, and keep all my **commandments** always, that it might be well with them, and with their children for ever!
- **5:31** But as for you, stand you here by me, and I will speak unto you all the **commandments**, and the statutes, and the judgments, which you shall teach them, that they may do them in the land which I give them to possess it.
- **6:1** Now these are the **commandments**, the statutes, and the judgments, which the LORD your God commanded to teach you, that you might do them in the land whither you go to possess it:
- **6:2** That you might fear the LORD your God, to keep all his statutes and his **commandments**, which I command you, you, and your son, and your son's son, all the days of your life; and that your days may be prolonged.
- 6:17 You shall diligently keep the commandments of the LORD your God, and his testimonies, and his statutes, which he has

commanded you.

- **6:25** And it shall be our righteousness, if we observe to do all these **commandments** before the LORD our God, as he has commanded us.
- **7:9** Know therefore that the LORD your God, he is God, the faithful God, which keeps covenant and mercy with them that love him and keep his **commandments** to a thousand generations;
- 7:11 Thou shall therefore keep the **commandments**, and the statutes, and the judgments, which I command you this day, to do them.
- **8:1** All the **commandments** which I command you this day shall you observe to do, that you may live, and multiply, and go in and possess the land which the LORD swore unto your fathers.
- **8:2** And you shall remember all the way which the LORD your God led you these forty years in the wilderness, to humble you, and to prove you, to know what was in your heart, whether you would keep his **commandments**, or no.
- **8:6** Therefore you shall keep the **commandments** of the LORD your God, to walk in his ways, and to fear him.
- **8:11** Beware that you forget not the LORD your God, in not keeping his **commandments**, and his judgments, and his statutes, which I command you this day:
- **10:4** And he wrote on the tables, according to the first writing, the ten **commandments**, which the LORD spoke unto you in the mount out of the midst of the fire in the day of the assembly: and the LORD gave them unto me.
- 10:13 To keep the commandments of the LORD, and his statutes, which I command you this day for your good?
- 11:1 Therefore you shall love the LORD your God, and keep his charge, and his statutes, and his judgments, and his commandments, always.
- 11:8 Therefore shall you keep all the **commandments** which I command you this day, that you may be strong, and go in and possess the land, whither you go to possess it.
- **11:13** And it shall come to pass, if you shall hearken diligently unto my **commandments** which I command you this day, to love the LORD your God, and to serve him with all your heart and with all your soul,
- 11:22 For if you shall diligently keep all these **commandments** which I command you, to do them, to love the LORD your God, to walk in all his ways, and to cleave unto him;
- 11:27 A blessing, if you obey the commandments of the LORD your God, which I command you this day:
- 11:28 And a curse, if you will not obey the **commandments** of the LORD your God, but turn aside out of the way which I command you this day, to go after other gods, which you have not known.
- **13:4** You shall walk after the LORD your God, and fear him, and keep his **commandments**, and obey his voice, and you shall serve him, and cleave unto him.
- 13:18 When you shall hearken to the voice of the LORD your God, to keep all his **commandments** which I command you this day, to do that which is right in the eyes of the LORD your God.
- **15:5** Only if you carefully hearken unto the voice of the LORD your God, to observe to do all these **commandments** which I command you this day.
- **19:9** If you shall keep all these **commandments** to do them, which I command you this day, to love the LORD your God, and to walk ever in his ways; then shall you add three cities more for you, beside these three:
- **26:13** Then you shall say before the LORD your God, I have brought away the hallowed things out of mine house, and also have given them unto the Levite, and unto the stranger, to the fatherless, and to the widow, according to all your **commandments** which you has commanded me: I have not transgressed your **commandments**, neither have I forgotten them:

- **26:17** Thou has avouched the LORD this day to be your God, and to walk in his ways, and to keep his statutes, and his **commandments**, and his judgments, and to hearken unto his voice:
- **26:18** And the LORD has avouched you this day to be his peculiar people, as he has promised you, and that you should keep all his **commandments**.
- **27:1** And Moses with the elders of Israel commanded the people, saying, Keep all the **commandments** which I command you this day.
- 27:10 Thou shall therefore obey the voice of the LORD your God, and do his **commandments** and his statutes, which I command you this day.
- **28:1** And it shall come to pass, if you shall hearken diligently unto the voice of the LORD your God, to observe and to do all his **commandments** which I command you this day, that the LORD your God will set you on high above all nations of the ear
- **28:9** The LORD shall establish you an holy people unto himself, as he has sworn unto you, if you shall keep the **commandments** of the LORD your God, and walk in his ways.
- **28:13** And the LORD shall make you the head, and not the tail; and you shall be above only, and you shall not be beneath; if that you hearken unto the **commandments** of the LORD your God, which I command you this day, to observe and to do them:
- **28:15** But it shall come to pass, if you wilt not hearken unto the voice of the LORD your God, to observe to do all his **commandments** and his statutes which I command you this day; that all these curses shall come upon you, and overtake you:
- **28:45** Moreover all these curses shall come upon you, and shall pursue you, and overtake you, till you be destroyed; because you hearkened not unto the voice of the LORD your God, to keep his **commandments** and his statutes which he commanded you:
- 30:8 And you shall return and obey the voice of the LORD, and do all his commandments which I command you this day.
- **30:10** If you shall hearken unto the voice of the LORD your God, to keep his **commandments** and his statutes which are written in this book of the **law**, and if you turn unto the LORD your God with all your heart, and with all your soul.
- **30:16** In that I command you this day to love the LORD your God, to walk in his ways, and to keep his **commandments** and his statutes and his judgments, that you may live and multiply: and the LORD your God shall bless you in the land whither you goes to possess it.
- **31:5** And the LORD shall give them up before your face, that you may do unto them according unto all the **commandments** which I have commanded you.

Joshua

22:5 But take diligent heed to do the commandment and the <u>law</u>, which Moses the servant of the LORD charged you, to love the LORD your God, and to walk in all his ways, and to keep his <u>commandments</u>, and to cleave unto him, and to serve him with all your heart and with all your soul.

Judges

- 2:17 And yet they would not hearken unto their judges, but they went a whoring after other gods, and bowed themselves unto them: they turned quickly out of the way which their fathers walked in, obeying the **commandments** of the LORD; but they did not so.
- **3:4** And they were to prove Israel by them, to know whether they would hearken unto the **commandments** of the LORD, which he commanded their fathers by the hand of Moses.

1 Samuel

15:11 It repents me that I have set up Saul to be king: for he is turned back from following me, and has not performed my **commandments**. And it grieved Samuel; and he cried unto the LORD all night.

1 Kings

- **2:3** And keep the charge of the LORD your God, to walk in his ways, to keep his statutes, and his **commandments**, and his judgments, and his testimonies, as it is written in the **law** of Moses, that you may prosper in all that you do, and whithersoever you turns thyself:
- **3:14** And if you wilt walk in my ways, to keep my statutes and my **commandments**, as your father David did walk, then I will lengthen your days.
- **6:12** Concerning this house which you art in building, if you wilt walk in my statutes, and execute my judgments, and keep all my **commandments** to walk in them; then will I perform my word with you, which I spoke unto David your father:
- **8:58** That he may incline our hearts unto him, to walk in all his ways, and to keep his **commandments**, and his statutes, and his judgments, which he commanded our fathers.
- **8:61** Let your heart therefore be perfect with the LORD our God, to walk in his statutes, and to keep his **commandments**, as at this day.
- **9:6** But if you shall at all turn from following me, you or your children, and will not keep my **commandments** and my statutes which I have set before you, but go and serve other gods, and worship them:
- **11:34** Howbeit I will not take the whole kingdom out of his hand: but I will make him prince all the days of his life for David my servant's sake, whom I chose, because he kept my **commandments** and my statutes:
- 11:38 And it shall be, if you wilt hearken unto all that I command you, and wilt walk in my ways, and do that is right in my sight, to keep my statutes and my **commandments**, as David my servant did; that I will be with you, and build you a sure house, as I built for David, and will give Israel unto you.
- **14:8** And rent the kingdom away from the house of David, and gave it you: and yet you has not been as my servant David, who kept my **commandments**, and who followed me with all his heart, to do that only which was right in mine eyes;
- **18:18** And he answered, I have not troubled Israel; but you, and your father's house, in that you have forsaken the **commandments** of the LORD, and you has followed Baal.

2 Kings

- 17:13 Yet the LORD testified against Israel, and against Judah, by all the prophets, and by all the seers, saying, Turn you from your evil ways, and keep my **commandments** and my statutes, according to all the **law** which I commanded your fathers, and which I sent to you by my servants the prophets.
- 17:16 And they left all the **commandments** of the LORD their God, and made them molten images, even two calves, and made a grove, and worshipped all the host of heaven, and served Baal.
- 17:19 Also Judah kept not the commandments of the LORD their God, but walked in the statutes of Israel which they made.
- **18:6** For he clave to the LORD, and departed not from following him, but kept his **commandments**, which the LORD commanded Moses.
- 23:3 And the king stood by a pillar, and made a covenant before the LORD, to walk after the LORD, and to keep his **commandments** and his testimonies and his statutes with all their heart and all their soul, to perform the words of this covenant that were written in this book. And all the people stood to the covenant.

1 Chronicles

- 28:7 Moreover I will establish his kingdom for ever, if he be constant to do my **commandments** and my judgments, as at this day.
- **28:8** Now therefore in the sight of all Israel the congregation of the LORD, and in the audience of our God, keep and seek for all the **commandments** of the LORD your God: that you may possess this good land, and leave it for an inheritance for your children after

you for ever.

29:19 And give unto Solomon my son a perfect heart, to keep your **commandments**, your testimonies, and your statutes, and to do all these things, and to build the palace, for the which I have made provision.

2 Chronicles

- 7:19 But if you turn away, and forsake my statutes and my **commandments**, which I have set before you, and shall go and serve other gods, and worship them.
- 17:4 But sought to the LORD God of his father, and walked in his commandments, and not after the doings of Israel.
- **24**:**20** And the Spirit of God came upon Zechariah the son of Jehoiada the priest, which stood above the people, and said unto them, Thus said God, Why transgress you the **commandments** of the LORD, that you cannot prosper? because you have forsaken the LORD, he has also forsaken you.
- 31:21 And in every work that he began in the service of the house of God, and in the <u>law</u>, and in the <u>commandments</u>, to seek his God, he did it with all his heart, and prospered.
- **34:31** And the king stood in his place, and made a covenant before the LORD, to walk after the LORD, and to keep his **commandments**, and his testimonies, and his statutes, with all his heart, and with all his soul, to perform the words of the covenant which are written in this book.

Ezra

- 7:11 Now this is the copy of the letter that the king Artaxerxes gave unto Ezra the priest, the scribe, even a scribe of the words of the **commandments** of the LORD, and of his statutes to Israel.
- 9:10 And now, O our God, what shall we say after this? For we have forsaken your commandments,
- **9:14** Should we again break your **commandments**, and join in affinity with the people of these abominations? would not you be angry with us till you had consumed us, so that there should be no remnant nor escaping?

Nehemiah

- 1:5 And said, I beseech you, O LORD God of heaven, the great and terrible God, that keeps covenant and mercy for them that love him and observe his **commandments**:
- 1:7 We have dealt very corruptly against you, and have not kept the **commandments**, nor the statutes, nor the judgments, which you commanded your servant Moses.
- **1:9** But if you turn unto me, and keep my **commandments**, and do them; though there were of you cast out unto the uttermost part of the heaven, yet will I gather them from thence, and will bring them unto the place that I have chosen to set my name there.
- **9:13** Thou came down also upon mount Sinai, and spoke with them from heaven, and gave them right judgments, and true **law**s, good statutes and **commandments**:
- 9:16 But they and our fathers dealt proudly, and hardened their necks, and hearkened not to your commandments,
- **9:29** And testified against them, that you might bring them again unto your <u>law</u>: yet they dealt proudly, and hearkened not unto your <u>commandments</u>, but sinned against your judgments, (which if a man do, he shall live in them;) and withdrew the shoulder, and hardened their neck, and would not hear
- **9:34** Neither have our kings, our princes, our priests, nor our fathers, kept your **law**, nor hearkened unto your **commandments** and your testimonies, wherewith you didst testify against them.
- **10:29** They clave to their brethren, their nobles, and entered into a curse, and into an oath, to walk in God's <u>law</u>, which was given by Moses the servant of God, and to observe and do all the <u>commandments</u> of the LORD our Lord, and his judgments and his statutes:

Psalms

- 78:7 That they might set their hope in God, and not forget the works of God, but keep his commandments:
- 89:31 If they break my statutes, and keep not my commandments;
- 103:18 To such as keep his covenant, and to those that remember his **commandments** to do them.
- 103:20 Bless the LORD, you his angels, that excel in strength, that do his **commandments**, hearkening unto the voice of his word.
- 111:7 The works of his hands are verity and judgment; all his **commandments** are sure.
- **111:10** The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom: a good understanding have all they that do his **commandments**: his praise endures for ever.
- 112:1 Praise you the LORD. Blessed is the man that fears the LORD, that delights greatly in his commandments.
- 119:6 Then shall I not be ashamed, when I have respect unto all your command
- 119:10 With my whole heart have I sought you: O let me not wander from your commandments.
- **119:19** I am a stranger in the earth: hide not your **commandments** from me.
- 119:21 Thou has rebuked the proud that are cursed, which do err from your commandments.
- 119:32 I will run the way of your commandments, when you shall enlarge my heart.
- 119:35 Make me to go in the path of your commandments; for therein do I delight.
- **119:47** And I will delight myself in your **commandments**, which I have loved.
- 119:48 My hands also will I lift up unto your commandments, which I have loved; and I will meditate in your statutes.
- 119:60 I made haste, and delayed not to keep your commandments.
- 119:66 Teach me good judgment and knowledge: for I have believed your commandments.
- 119:73 JOD. Thy hands have made me and fashioned me: give me understanding, that I may learn your commandments.
- 119:86 All your commandments are faithful: they persecute me wrongfully; help you me.
- 119:98 Thou through your commandments has made me wiser than mine enemies: for they are ever with me.
- 119:115 Depart from me, you evildoers: for I will keep the **commandments** of my God.
- 119:127 Therefore I love your commandments above gold; yes, above fine gold.
- 119:131 I opened my mouth, and panted: for I longed for your commandments.
- 119:143 Trouble and anguish have taken hold on me: yet your commandments are my delights.
- 119:151 Thou art near, O LORD; and all your commandments are truth.
- 119:166 LORD, I have hoped for your salvation, and done your commandments.
- 119:172 My tongue shall speak of your word: for all your commandments are righteousness.
- 119:176 I have gone astray like a lost sheep; seek your servant; for I do not forget your commandments.

Proverbs

- 2:1 My son, if you wilt receive my words, and hide my commandments with you.
- 3:1 My son, forget not my law; but let your heart keep my commandments:
- 4:4 He taught me also, and said unto me, Let your heart retain my words: keep my commandments, and live.
- 7:1 My son, keep my words, and lay up my **commandments** with you.
- 7:2 Keep my **commandments**, and live; and my **law** as the apple of your eye.
- 10:8 The wise in heart will receive **commandments**: but a prating fool shall fall.

Ecclesiastes

12:13 Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God, and keep his **commandments**: for this is the whole duty of man.

Isaiah

48:18 O that you had hearkened to my **commandments**! then had your peace been as a river, and your righteousness as the waves of the sea:

Daniel

9:4 And I prayed unto the LORD my God, and made my confession, and said, O Lord, the great and dreadful God, keeping the covenant and mercy to them that love him, and to them that keep his **commandments**.

Amos

2:4 Thus said the LORD; For three transgressions of Judah, and for four, I will not turn away the punishment thereof; because they have despised the <u>law</u> of the LORD, and have not kept his <u>commandments</u>, and their lies caused them to err, after the which their fathers have walked:

Matthew

- **5:19** Whosoever therefore shall break one of these least **commandments**, and shall teach men so, he shall be called the least in the kingdom of heaven: but whosoever shall do and teach them, the same shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven.
- 19:17 And he said unto him, Why call you me good? There is none good but one, that is, God: but if you wilt enter into life, keep the **commandments**.
- 22:40 On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets.

Mark

- 10:19 Thou know the **commandments**, Do not commit adultery, Do not kill, Do not steal, Do not bear false witness, Defraud not, Honor thy father and mother.
- 12:29 And Jesus answered him, The first of all the **commandments** is, Hear, O Israel; The Lord our God is one Lord:

Luke

- 1:6 And they were both righteous before God, walking in all the commandments and ordinances of the Lord blameless.
- **18:20** Thou know the **commandments**, Do not commit adultery, Do not kill, Do not steal, Do not bear false witness, Honor thy father and thy mother.

John

- 14:15 If you love me, keep my commandments.
- **14:21** He that has my **commandments**, and keeps them, he it is that loves me: and he that loves me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him.
- **15:10** If you keep my **commandments**, you shall abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father's **commandments**, and abide in his love.

Acts

- **1:2** Until the day in which he was taken up, after that he through the Holy Ghost had given **commandments** unto the apostles whom he had chosen:
- 7:53 Who have received the **law** by the disposition of angels, and have not kept it.
- 13:15 And after the reading of the <u>law</u> and the prophets the rulers of the synagogue sent unto them, saying, You men and brethren, if you have any word of exhortation for the people, say on.
- 21:20 And when they heard it, they glorified the Lord, and said unto him.
- 21:24 Them take, and purify thyself with them, and be at charges with them, that they may shave their heads: and all may know that those things, whereof they were informed concerning you, are nothing; but that you thyself also walk orderly, and keeps the <u>law</u>.
- **24:14** But this I confess unto you, that after the way which they call heresy, so worship I the God of my fathers, believing all things which are written in the \underline{law} and in the prophets:
- **25:8** While he answered for himself, Neither against the <u>law</u> of the Jews, neither against the temple, nor yet against Caesar, have I offended any thing at all.

Romans

- 2:12 For as many as have sinned without <u>law</u> shall also perish without <u>law</u>: and as many as have sinned in the <u>law</u> shall be judged by the <u>law</u>;
- 2:13 (For not the hearers of the law are just before God, but the doers of the law shall be justified.
- 2:14 For when the Gentiles, which have not the <u>law</u>, do by nature the things contained in the <u>law</u>, these, having not the <u>law</u>, are a <u>law</u> unto themselves.
- 2:15 Which show the work of the <u>law</u> written in their hearts, their conscience also bearing witness, and their thoughts the mean while accusing or else excusing one another;
- 2:17 Behold, you art called a Jew, and rests in the <u>law</u>, and makes thy boast of God,
- 2:18 And know his will, and approves the things that are more excellent, being instructed out of the law.
- 2:20 An instructor of the foolish, a teacher of babes, which has the form of knowledge and of the truth in the law.
- 2:23 Thou that makes thy boast of the <u>law</u>, through breaking the <u>law</u> dishonors you God?
- 3:19 Now we know that what things so ever the <u>law</u> said, it said to them who are under the <u>law</u>: that every mouth may be stopped, and all the world may become guilty before God
- 3:20 Therefore by the deeds of the **law** there shall no flesh be justified in his sight: for by the **law** is the knowledge of sin.

- 3:21 But now the righteousness of God without the <u>law</u> is manifested, being witnessed by the <u>law</u> and the prophets;
- 3:27 Where is boasting then? It is excluded. By what <u>law</u>? of works? Nay: but by the <u>law</u> of faith.
- 3:28 Therefore we conclude that a man is justified by faith without the deeds of the <u>law</u>.
- 3:31 Do we then make void the <u>law</u> through faith? God forbid: yea, we establish the <u>law</u>.
- **4:15** Because the <u>law</u> works wrath: for where no <u>law</u> is, there is no transgression.
- 5:13 (For until the <u>law</u> sin was in the world: but sin is not imputed when there is no <u>law</u>.
- 5:20 Moreover the law entered, that the offence might abound. But where sin abounded, grace did much more abound:
- 6:14 For sin shall not have dominion over you: for you are not under the law, but under grace.
- 7:1 Know you not, brethren, (for I speak to them that know the **law**,) how that the **law** has dominion over a man as long as he lives?
- 7:3 So then if, while her husband lives, she be married to another man, she shall be called an adulteress: but if her husband be dead, she is free from that <u>law</u>; so that she is no adulteress, though she be married to another man.
- 7:7 What shall we say then? is the <u>law</u> sin? God forbid. Nay, I had not known sin, but by the <u>law</u>: for I had not known lust, except the <u>law</u> had said, Thou shall not covet.
- 7:8 But sin, taking occasion by the commandment, wrought in me all manner of concupiscence. For with out the \underline{law} sin was dead.
- 7:9 For I was alive without the law once: but when the commandment came, sin revived, and I died.
- 7:12 Wherefore the **law** is holy, and the commandment holy, and just, and good.
- 7:14 For we know that the <u>law</u> is spiritual: but I am carnal, sold under sin.
- 7:16 If then I do that which I would not, I consent unto the law that it is good.
- 7:22 For I delight in the <u>law</u> of God after the inward man:
- 7:25 I thank God through Jesus Christ our Lord. So then with the mind I myself serve the <u>law</u> of God; but with the flesh the <u>law</u> of sin.
- 8:2 For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death.
- **8:3** For what the <u>law</u> could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh:
- 8:4 That the righteousness of the <u>law</u> might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.
- 8:7 Because the carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be.
- 13:8 Owe no man any thing, but to love one another: for he that loves another has fulfilled the <u>law</u>.
- 13:9 For this, Thou shall not commit adultery, Thou shall not kill, Thou shall not steal, Thou shall not bear false witness, Thou shall not covet; and if there be any other commandment, it is briefly comprehended in this saying, namely, Thou shall love thy neighbor as thyself.
- 13:10 Love works no ill to his neighbor: therefore love is the fulfilling of the <u>law</u>.

1 Corinthians

- 7:19 Circumcision is nothing, and uncircumcision is nothing, but the keeping of the commandments of God.
- **14:37** If any man think himself to be a prophet, or spiritual, let him acknowledge that the things that I write unto you are the **commandments** of the Lord.

1 Thessalonians

4:2 For you know what **commandments** we gave you by the Lord Jesus.

1 John

- 2:3 And hereby we do know that we know him, if we keep his **commandments**.
- 2:4 He that said, I know him, and keeps not his commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him.
- **3:22** And whatsoever we ask, we receive of him, because we keep his **commandments**, and do those things that are pleasing in his sight.
- **3:24** And he that keeps his **commandments** dwells in him, and he in him. And hereby we know that he abides in us, by the Spirit which he has given us.
- 5:2 By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God, and keep his commandments.
- 5:3 For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments: and his commandments are not grievous.

2 John

1:6 And this is love, that we walk after his **commandments**. This is the commandment, That, as you have heard from the beginning, you should walk in it.

Revelation

- 11:19 And the temple of God was opened in heaven, and there was seen in his temple the **ark of his testament**: and there were lightning, and voices, and thundering, and an earthquake, and great hail.
- 12:17 And the dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with the remnant of her seed, which keep the **commandments** of God, and have the testimony of Jesus Christ.
- 14:12 Here is the patience of the saints: here are they that keep the commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus.
- 15:5 And after that I looked, and, behold, the temple of the tabernacle of the testimony in heaven was opened:
- 22:14 Blessed are they that do his **commandments**, that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city.
