Commandment 1

1 And God spoke all these words, saying, 2 I am the LORD your God, which have brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage. 3 Thou shall have no other gods before me. **Exodus 20:1-2.**

Acts

Then Peter and the other apostles answered and said, We ought to obey God rather than men. Acts 5:29

And the nation to whom they shall be in bondage will I judge, said God: and after that shall they come forth, and serve me in this place. Acts 7:7

Amen. 26 For this cause God gave them up unto vile affections: for even their women did change the natural use into that which is against nature: 27 And likewise also the men, leaving the natural use of the woman, burned in their lust one toward another; men with men working that which is unseemly, and receiving in themselves that recompense of their error which was meet. 28 And even as they did not like to retain God in their knowledge, God gave them over to a reprobate mind, to do those things which are not convenient; 29 Being filled with all unrighteousness, fornication, wickedness, covetousness, maliciousness; full of envy, murder, debate, deceit, malignity; whisperers, 30 Backbiters, haters of God, despiteful, proud, boasters, inventors of evil things, disobedient to parents, 31 Without understanding, covenant breakers, without natural affection, implacable, unmerciful: 32 Who knowing the judgment of God, that they which commit such things are worthy of death, not only do the same, but have pleasure in them that do them. Romans 1:21-32

4 Thou shall not make unto you any graven image, or any likeness of any thing that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth: 5 Thou shall not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD your God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate me; 6 And showing mercy unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments. Exodus 20:4-6.

Acts

Yea, you took up the tabernacle of Moloch, and the star of your god Remphan, figures which you made to worship them: and I will carry you away beyond Babylon. Acts 7:43

- 20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and from fornication, and from things strangled, and from blood. 29 That you abstain from meats offered to idols, and from blood, and from things strangled, and from fornication: from which if you keep yourselves, you shall do well. Fare you well. Acts 15:20,29
- **16** Now while Paul waited for them at Athens, his spirit was stirred in him, when he saw the city wholly given to idolatry. **29** Forasmuch then as we are the offspring of God, we ought not to think that the Godhead is like unto gold, or silver, or stone, graven by art and man's device. Acts 17:16,29

As touching the Gentiles which believe, we have written and concluded that they observe no such thing, save only that they keep themselves from things offered to idols, and from blood, and from strangled, and from fornication. Acts 21:25

And when the town clerk had appeased the people, he said, You men of Ephesus, what man is there that knows not how that the city of the Ephesians is a worshipper of the great goddess Diana, and of the image which fell down from Jupiter? Acts 19:35

Romans

And changed the glory of the uncorruptible God into an image made like to corruptible man, and to birds, and four footed beasts, and creeping things. Romans 1:23

Thou that say a man should not commit adultery, dost you commit adultery? you that abhors idols, dost you commit sacrilege? Romans 2:22

But what said the answer of God unto him? I have reserved to myself seven thousand men, who have not bowed the knee to the image of Baal. Romans 11:4

1 Corinthians

10 Yet not altogether with the fornicators of this world, or with the covetous, or extortionist, or with idolaters; for then must you needs go out of the world. 11 But now I have written unto you not to keep company, if any man that is called a brother be a fornicator, or covetous, or an idolater, or a railer, or a drunkard, or an extortionist; with such an one no not to eat. 1 Corinthians 5:10-11

2 Corinthians

And what agreement has the temple of God with idols? for you are the temple of the living God; as God has said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people. 2 Corinthians 6:16

Galatians

Idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies. Galatians 5:20

Ephesians

For this you know, that no whoremonger, nor unclean person, nor covetous man, who is an idolater, has any inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and of God. Ephesians 5:5

Colossians

Mortify therefore your members which are upon the earth; fornication, uncleanness, inordinate affection, evil concupiscence, and covetousness, which is idolatry. Colossians 3:5

But I have a few things against you, because you has there them that hold the doctrine of Balaam, who taught Balac to cast a stumbling block before the children of Israel, to eat things sacrificed unto idols, and to commit fornication. Revelation 2:14

Notwithstanding I have a few things against you, because you suffered that woman Jezebel, which calls herself a prophetess, to teach and to seduce my servants to commit fornication, and to eat things sacrificed unto idols. Revelation 2:20

And the rest of the men which were not killed by these plagues yet repented not of the works of their hands, that they should not worship devils, and idols of gold, and silver, and brass, and stone, and of wood: which neither can see, nor hear, nor walk: Revelation 9:20

- 14 And deceives them that dwell on the earth by the means of those miracles which he had power to do in the sight of the beast; saying to them that dwell on the earth, that they should make an image to the beast, which had the wound by a sword, and did live. 15 And he had power to give life unto the image of the beast, that the image of the beast should both speak, and cause that as many as would not worship the image of the beast should be killed. Revelation 13:14-15
- **9** And the third angel followed them, saying with a loud voice, If any man worship the beast and his image, and receive his mark in his forehead, or in his hand, **11** And the smoke of their torment ascends up for ever and ever: and they have no rest day nor night, who worship the beast and his image, and whosoever receives the mark of his name. Who was before a blasphemer, and a persecutor, and injurious: but I obtained mercy, because I did it ignorantly in unbelief. 1 Timothy 1:13

Of whom is Hymenaeus and Alexander; whom I have delivered unto Satan, that they may learn not to blaspheme. 1 Timothy 1:20

Let as many servants as are under the yoke count their own masters worthy of all honor, that the name of God and his doctrine be not blasphemed. 1 Timothy 6:1

For men shall be lovers of their own selves, covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy. 2 Timothy 3:2

Titus

To be discreet, chaste, keepers at home, good, obedient to their own husbands, that the word of God be not blasphemed. Titus 2:5

Hebrews

Of how much sorer punishment, suppose you, shall he be thought worthy, who has trodden under foot the Son of God, and has counted the blood of the covenant, wherewith he was sanctified, an unholy thing, and has done despite unto the Spirit of grace? Hebrews 10:29

Do not they blaspheme that worthy name by the which you are called? James 2:7

2 Peter

6 And turning the cities of Sodom and Gomorrah into ashes condemned them with an overthrow, making them an ensample unto those that after should live ungodly; **7** And delivered just Lot, vexed with the filthy conversation of the wicked: **8** (For that righteous man dwelling among them, in seeing and hearing, vexed his righteous soul from day to day with their unlawful deeds.) 2 Peter 2:6-8

Revelation

I know thy works, and tribulation, and poverty, (but you art rich) and I know the blasphemy of them which say they are Jews, and are not, but are the synagogue of Satan. Revelation 2:9

20 Notwithstanding I have a few things against you, because you suffered that woman Jezebel, which calls herself a prophetess, to

teach and to seduce my servants to commit fornication, and to eat things sacrificed unto idols. **21** And I gave her space to repent of her fornication; and she repented not. **22** Behold, I will cast her into a bed, and them that commit adultery with her into great tribulation, except they repent of their deeds. Revelation 2:20-22

And I stood upon the sand of the sea, and saw a beast rise up out of the sea, having seven heads and ten horns, and upon his horns ten crowns, and upon his heads the name of blasphemy. Revelation 13:1

And there was given unto him a mouth speaking great things and blasphemies; and power was given unto him to continue forty and two months. 6 And he opened his mouth in blasphemy against God, to blaspheme his name, and his tabernacle, and them that dwell in heaven. Revelation 13:5-6

And in their mouth was found no guile: for they are without fault before the throne of God. Revelation 14:5

And men were scorched with great heat, and blasphemed the name of God, which has power over these plagues: and they repented not to give him glory. Revelation 16:9

And blasphemed the God of heaven because of their pains and their sores, and repented not of their deeds. Revelation 16:11

And there fell upon men a great hail out of heaven, every stone about the weight of a talent: and men blasphemed God because of the plague of the hail; for the plague thereof was exceeding great. Revelation 16:21

1 And there came one of the seven angels which had the seven vials, and talked with me, saying unto me, Come hither; I will show unto you the judgment of the great whore that sits upon many waters: 2 With whom the kings of the earth have committed fornication, and the inhabitants of the earth have been made drunk with the wine of her fornication. 3 So he carried me away in the spirit into the wilderness: and I saw a woman sit upon a scarlet colored beast, full of names of blasphemy, having seven heads and ten horns. 4

And the woman was arrayed in purple and scarlet color, and decked with gold and precious stones and pearls, having a golden cup in her hand full of abominations and filthiness of her fornication: **5** And upon her forehead was a name written, MYSTERY, BABYLON THE GREAT, THE MOTHER OF HARLOTS AND ABOMINATIONS OF THE EARTH. Revelation 17:1-5

For without are dogs, and sorcerers, and whoremongers, and murderers, and idolaters, and whosoever loves and makes a lie. Revelation 22:15

Commandment 4

Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy. **9** Six days shall you labor, and do all your work: **10** But the seventh day is the Sabbath of the LORD your God: in it you shall not do any work, you, nor your son, nor your daughter, your manservant, nor your maidservant, nor your cattle, nor your stranger that is within your gates: **11** For in six days the LORD made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them is, and rested the seventh day: wherefore the LORD blessed the Sabbath day, and hallowed it. **Exodus 20:8-11.**

Acts

Then returned they unto Jerusalem from the mount called Olivet, which is from Jerusalem a Sabbath day's journey. Acts 1:12

But when they departed from Perga, they came to Antioch in Pisidia, and went into the synagogue on the Sabbath day, and sat down. Acts 13:14

For they that dwell at Jerusalem, and their rulers, because they knew him not, nor yet the voices of the prophets which are read every Sabbath day, they have fulfilled them in condemning him. Acts 13:27

42 And when the Jews were gone out of the synagogue, the Gentiles besought that these words might be preached to them the next Sabbath. **43** Now when the congregation was broken up, many of the Jews and religious proselytes followed Paul and Barnabas: who, speaking to them, persuaded them to continue in the grace of God. **44** And the next Sabbath day came almost the whole city together to hear the word of God. Acts 13:42-44

For Moses of old time has in every city them that preach him, being read in the synagogues every Sabbath day. Acts 15:21

And on the Sabbath we went out of the city by a river side, where prayer was wont to be made; and we sat down, and spoke unto the women which resorted thither. Acts 16:13

And Paul, as his manner was, went in unto them, and three Sabbath days reasoned with them out of the scriptures. Acts 17:2

4 And he reasoned in the synagogue every Sabbath, and persuaded the Jews and the Greeks. 5 And when Silas and Timothy were come from Macedonia, Paul was pressed in the spirit, and testified to the Jews that Jesus was Christ. 11 And he continued there a year and six months, teaching the word of God among them. Acts 18:4-11

Hebrews

4 For he spoke in a certain place of the seventh day on this wise, And God did rest the seventh day from all his works. **9** There remains therefore a rest to the people of God. Hebrews 4:4, 9

Revelation

For this, Thou shall not commit adultery, Thou shall not kill, Thou shall not steal, Thou shall not bear false witness, Thou shall not covet; and if there be any other commandment, it is briefly comprehended in this saying, namely, Thou shall love thy neighbor as thyself. Romans 13:9

He that said, I know him, and keeps not his commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him. 1 John 2:4

21 I have not written unto you because you know not the truth, but because you know it, and that no lie is of the truth. 22 Who is a liar but he that denies that Jesus is the Christ? He is antichrist, that denies the Father and the Son. 1 John 2:21-22

But the anointing which you have received of him abides in you, and you need not that any man teach you: but as the same anointing teaches you of all things, and is truth, and is no lie, and even as it has taught you, you shall abide in him. 1 John 2:27

Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world. 1 John 4:1

We are of God: he that knows God hears us; he that is not of God hears not us. Hereby know we the spirit of truth, and the spirit of error. 1 John 4:6

If a man say, I love God, and hates his brother, he is a liar: for he that loves not his brother whom he has seen, how can he love God whom he has not seen? 1 John 4:20

He that believeth on the Son of God has the witness in himself: he that believeth not God has made him a liar; because he believeth not the record that God gave of his Son. 1 John 5:10

2 John

For many deceivers are entered into the world, who confess not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh. This is a deceiver and an antichrist. 2 John 1:7

Revelation

I know thy works, and thy labor, and thy patience, and how you canst not bear them which are evil: and you has tried them which say they are apostles, and are not, and has found them liars. Revelation 2:2

19 Who being past feeling have given themselves over unto lasciviousness, to work all uncleanness with greediness. 22 That you put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts. Ephesians 4:19, 22

Colossians

Mortify therefore your members which are upon the earth; fornication, uncleanness, inordinate affection, evil concupiscence, and covetousness, which is idolatry: Colossians 3:5

1 Thessalonians

For neither at any time used we flattering words, as you know, nor a cloak of covetousness; God is witness: 1 Thessalonians 2:5

1 Timothy

- **3** Not given to wine, no striker, not greedy of filthy lucre; but patient, not a brawler, not covetous; **8** Like wise must the deacons be grave, not double tongued, not given to much wine, not greedy of filthy lucre. 1 Timothy 3:3, 8
- **9** But they that will be rich fall into temptation and a snare, and into many foolish and hurtful lusts, which drown men in destruction and perdition. **10** For the love of money is the root of all evil: which while some coveted after, they have erred from the faith, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows. 1 Timothy 6:9-10

2 Timothy

Flee also youthful lusts: but follow righteousness, faith, charity, peace, with them that call on the Lord out of a pure heart. 2 Timothy 2:22

For men shall be lovers of their own selves, covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy. 2 Timothy 3:2

For of this sort are they which creep into houses, and lead captive silly women laden with sins, led away with divers lusts. 2 Timothy 3:6

For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears. 2 Timothy 4:3

Titus

Teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly, in this present world. Titus 2:12

- 1 Go to now, you rich men, weep and howl for your miseries that shall come upon you. 2 Your riches are corrupted, and your garments are moth eaten. 3 Your gold and silver is cankered; and the rust of them shall be a witness against you, and shall eat your flesh as it were fire. You have heaped treasure together for the last days. 4 Behold, the hire of the laborers who have reaped down your fields, which is of you kept back by fraud, cries: and the cries of them which have reaped are entered into the ears of the Lord of sabaoth. 5

You have lived in pleasure on the earth, and been wanton; you have nourished your hearts, as in a day of slaughter. James 5:1-5

As obedient children, not fashioning yourselves according to the former lusts in your ignorance: 1 Peter 1:14

1 Peter

Dearly beloved, I beseech you as strangers and pilgrims, abstain from fleshly lusts, which war against the soul. 1 Peter 2:11

2 That he no longer should live the rest of his time in the flesh to the lusts of men, but to the will of God. 3 For the time past of our life may suffice us to have wrought the will of the Gentiles, when we walked in lasciviousness, lusts, excess of wine, reveling, banqueting, and abominable idolatries. 1 Peter 4:2-3

2 Peter

For when they speak great swelling words of vanity, they allure through the lusts of the flesh, through much wantonness, those that were clean escaped from them who live in error. 2 Peter 2:18

Knowing this first, that there shall come in the last days scoffers, walking after their own lusts. 2 Peter 3:3

1 John

16 For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world. **17** And the world passed away, and the lust thereof: but he that does the will of God abides for ever. 1 John 2:16-17

Revelation

13 And one of the elders answered, saying unto me, What are these which are arrayed in white robes? And whence came they? 14 And I said unto him, Sir, you know. And every shipmaster, and all the company in ships, and sailors, and as many as trade by sea, stood afar off, 18 And cried when they saw the smoke of her burning, saying, What city is like unto this great city! 19 And they cast dust on their heads, and cried, weeping and wailing, saying, Alas, alas, that great city, wherein were made rich all that had ships in the sea by reason of her costliness! For in one hour is she made desolate. Revelation 18:9-19

Matthew

- **5:19** Whosoever therefore shall break one of these least **commandments**, and shall teach men so, he shall be called the least in the kingdom of heaven: but whosoever shall do and teach them, the same shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven.
- **19:17** And he said unto him, Why call you me good? There is none good but one, that is, God: but if you wilt enter into life, keep the **commandments**.
- 22:40 On these two **commandments** hang all the **law** and the prophets.

Mark

- 10:19 Thou know the **commandments**, Do not commit adultery, Do not kill, Do not steal, Do not bear false witness, Defraud not, Honor thy father and mother.
- 12:29 And Jesus answered him, The first of all the commandments is, Hear, O Israel; The Lord our God is one Lord:

Luke

- 1:6 And they were both righteous before God, walking in all the commandments and ordinances of the Lord blameless.
- **18:20** Thou know the **commandments**, Do not commit adultery, Do not kill, Do not steal, Do not bear false witness, Honor thy father and thy mother.

John

- 14:15 If you love me, keep my commandments.
- **14:21** He that has my **commandments**, and keeps them, he it is that loves me: and he that loves me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him.
- **15:10** If you keep my **commandments**, you shall abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father's **commandments**, and abide in his love.

Acts

1:2 Until the day in which he was taken up, after that he through the Holy Ghost had given commandments unto

the apostles whom he had chosen:

- 7:53 Who have received the **law** by the disposition of angels, and have not kept it.
- 13:15 And after the reading of the <u>law</u> and the prophets the rulers of the synagogue sent unto them, saying, You men and brethren, if you have any word of exhortation for the people, say on.
- 21:20 And when they heard it, they glorified the Lord, and said unto him.
- 21:24 Them take, and purify thyself with them, and be at charges with them, that they may shave their heads: and all may know that those things, whereof they were informed concerning you, are nothing; but that you thyself also walk orderly, and keeps the law.
- **24:14** But this I confess unto you, that after the way which they call heresy, so worship I the God of my fathers, believing all things which are written in the <u>law</u> and in the prophets:
- 25:8 While he answered for himself, Neither against the <u>law</u> of the Jews, neither against the temple, nor yet against Caesar, have I offended any thing at all.

Romans

- 2:12 For as many as have sinned without <u>law</u> shall also perish without <u>law</u>: and as many as have sinned in the <u>law</u> shall be judged by the <u>law</u>;
- 2:13 (For not the hearers of the law are just before God, but the doers of the law shall be justified.
- 2:14 For when the Gentiles, which have not the <u>law</u>, do by nature the things contained in the <u>law</u>, these, having not the <u>law</u>, are a <u>law</u> unto themselves.
- 2:15 Which show the work of the <u>law</u> written in their hearts, their conscience also bearing witness, and their thoughts the mean while accusing or else excusing one another;
- 2:17 Behold, you art called a Jew, and rests in the <u>law</u>, and makes thy boast of God,
- 2:18 And know his will, and approves the things that are more excellent, being instructed out of the <u>law</u>.
- 2:20 An instructor of the foolish, a teacher of babes, which has the form of knowledge and of the truth in the law.
- 2:23 Thou that makes thy boast of the law, through breaking the law dishonors you God?
- 3:19 Now we know that what things so ever the <u>law</u> said, it said to them who are under the <u>law</u>: that every mouth may be stopped, and all the world may become guilty before God
- 3:20 Therefore by the deeds of the <u>law</u> there shall no flesh be justified in his sight: for by the <u>law</u> is the knowledge of sin.
- 3:21 But now the righteousness of God without the <u>law</u> is manifested, being witnessed by the <u>law</u> and the prophets;
- 3:27 Where is boasting then? It is excluded. By what <u>law</u>? of works? Nay: but by the <u>law</u> of faith.
- 3:28 Therefore we conclude that a man is justified by faith without the deeds of the <u>law</u>.
- 3:31 Do we then make void the <u>law</u> through faith? God forbid: yea, we establish the <u>law</u>.
- 4:15 Because the <u>law</u> works wrath: for where no <u>law</u> is, there is no transgression.
- 5:13 (For until the <u>law</u> sin was in the world: but sin is not imputed when there is no <u>law</u>.
- 5:20 Moreover the <u>law</u> entered, that the offence might abound. But where sin abounded, grace did much more abound:
- 6:14 For sin shall not have dominion over you: for you are not under the law, but under grace.

- 7:1 Know you not, brethren, (for I speak to them that know the **law**,) how that the **law** has dominion over a man as long as he lives?
- 7:3 So then if, while her husband lives, she be married to another man, she shall be called an adulteress: but if her husband be dead, she is free from that **law**; so that she is no adulteress, though she be married to another man.
- 7:7 What shall we say then? is the **law** sin? God forbid. Nay, I had not known sin, but by the **law**: for I had not known lust, except the **law** had said, Thou shall not covet.
- 7:8 But sin, taking occasion by the commandment, wrought in me all manner of concupiscence. For with out the <u>law</u> sin was dead.
- 7:9 For I was alive without the **law** once: but when the commandment came, sin revived, and I died.
- 7:12 Wherefore the <u>law</u> is holy, and the commandment holy, and just, and good.
- 7:14 For we know that the <u>law</u> is spiritual: but I am carnal, sold under sin.
- 7:16 If then I do that which I would not, I consent unto the law that it is good.
- 7:22 For I delight in the <u>law</u> of God after the inward man:
- 7:25 I thank God through Jesus Christ our Lord. So then with the mind I myself serve the <u>law</u> of God; but with the flesh the <u>law</u> of sin.
- 8:2 For the <u>law</u> of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the <u>law</u> of sin and death.
- 8:3 For what the <u>law</u> could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh:
- 8:4 That the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.
- 8:7 Because the carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be.
- 13:8 Owe no man any thing, but to love one another: for he that loves another has fulfilled the <u>law</u>.
- 13:9 For this, Thou shall not commit adultery, Thou shall not kill, Thou shall not steal, Thou shall not bear false witness, Thou shall not covet; and if there be any other commandment, it is briefly comprehended in this saying, namely, Thou shall love thy neighbor as thyself.
- 13:10 Love works no ill to his neighbor: therefore love is the fulfilling of the <u>law</u>.

1 Corinthians

- 7:19 Circumcision is nothing, and uncircumcision is nothing, but the keeping of the commandments of God.
- **14:37** If any man think himself to be a prophet, or spiritual, let him acknowledge that the things that I write unto you are the **commandments** of the Lord.

1 Thessalonians

4:2 For you know what **commandments** we gave you by the Lord Jesus.

1 John

- 2:3 And hereby we do know that we know him, if we keep his commandments.
- 2:4 He that said, I know him, and keeps not his commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him.

- 3:22 And whatsoever we ask, we receive of him, because we keep his **commandments**, and do those things that are pleasing in his sight.
- **3:24** And he that keeps his **commandments** dwells in him, and he in him. And hereby we know that he abides in us, by the Spirit which he has given us.
- 5:2 By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God, and keep his commandments.
- 5:3 For this is the love of God, that we keep his **commandments**: and his **commandments** are not grievous.

2 John

1:6 And this is love, that we walk after his **commandments**. This is the commandment, That, as you have heard from the beginning, you should walk in it.

Revelation

- 11:19 And the temple of God was opened in heaven, and there was seen in his temple the **ark of his testament**: and there were lightning, and voices, and thundering, and an earthquake, and great hail.
- 12:17 And the dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with the remnant of her seed, which keep the **commandments** of God, and have the testimony of Jesus Christ.
- 14:12 Here is the patience of the saints: here are they that keep the **commandments** of God, and the faith of Jesus.
- 15:5 And after that I looked, and, behold, the temple of the tabernacle of the testimony in heaven was opened:
- 22:14 Blessed are they that do his **commandments**, that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city.
