Old Testament References

1. Our meditation all the day long.

Blessed [is] the man that walks not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor stands in the way of sinners, nor sits in the seat of the scornful. But his delight [is] in the <u>law</u> of the LORD; and in his <u>law</u> does he meditate day and night. And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that brings forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he does shall prosper. **Psalm 1:1-3.**

2. The law of God is perfect converting the soul.

The <u>law</u> of the LORD [is] perfect, converting the soul: the testimony of the LORD [is] sure, making wise the simple. The statutes of the LORD [are] right, rejoicing the heart: the commandment of the LORD [is] pure, enlightening the eyes. **Psalm 19:7-8.**

3. God's law is a delight within our heart.

I delight to do thy will, O my God: yea, thy **law** is within my heart. **Psalm 40:8.**

4. The Ten Commandments are for His people.

For he established a testimony in Jacob, and appointed a <u>law</u> in Israel, which he commanded our fathers, that they should make them known to their children. That the generation to come might know them, even the children which should be born. Who should arise and declare [them] to their children. That they might set their hope in God, and not forget the works of God, but keep his commandments. **Psalm 78:1-7.**

5. The eternal law of God

The works of his hands are verity and judgment; all his commandments are sure. They stand fast for ever and ever, and are done in truth and uprightness. **Psalm 111:7, 8.**

6. The angels keep the commandments of God.

To such as keep his covenant, and to those that remember his commandments to do them. The LORD hath prepared his throne in the heavens; and his kingdom rules over all. Bless the LORD, you his angels, that excel in strength, that do his commandments, hearkening unto the voice of his word. **Psalm 103:18-20.**

7. The Ten Commandments are binding for 20,000 years.

He hath remembered his covenant for ever, the word which he commanded to a thousand generations. Which covenant he made with Abraham, and his oath unto Isaac. And confirmed the same unto Jacob for a <u>law</u>, and to Israel for an everlasting covenant. **Psalm 105:8-10.**

8. God will destroy the lawless ones.

It is time for thee, LORD, to work: for they have made void thy <u>law</u>. They draw nigh that follow after mischief: they are far from thy <u>law</u>. Psalm 119:126,150.

9. The law is our guide and lamp.

Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path. **Psalm 119:105.**

10. Depart from evil and obey the Commandments

Depart from me, you evildoers: for I will keep the commandments of my God. Psalm 119:115.

11. It is our peace and delight.

Great peace have they which love thy <u>law</u>: and nothing shall offend them. I have longed for thy salvation, O LORD; and thy <u>law</u> is my delight. **Psalm 119:165, 174.**

12. Our whole duty before God.

Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God, and keep his commandments: for this is the whole duty of man. For God shall bring every work into judgment, with every secret thing, whether it be good, or whether it be evil. **Ecclesiastes 12:13.**

13. God will seal the law among His disciples.

Bind up the testimony, seal the **law** among my disciples. **Isaiah 8:16.**

14. The commandments are a test of truth and error.

To the <u>law</u> and to the testimony: if they speak not according to this word, [it is] because [there is] no light in them. **Isaiah 8:20.**

15. The Sabbath will be kept in heaven.

For as the new heavens and the new earth, which I will make, shall remain before me, said the LORD, so shall your seed and your name remain. And it shall come to pass, that from one new moon to another, and from one Sabbath to another, shall all flesh come to worship before me, said the LORD. **Isaiah 66:22-24.**

New Testament References

1. Jesus came to uphold the Ten Commandments.

Think not that I am come to destroy the <u>law</u>, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfill. For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the <u>law</u>, till all be fulfilled. Whosoever therefore shall break one of these least commandments, and shall teach men so, he shall be called the least in the kingdom of heaven: but whosoever shall do and teach [them], the same shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven. **Matthew 5:17-19.**

2. Keep the Ten Commandments

And he said unto him, Why do you call me good? There is none good but one, [that is], God: but if thou wilt enter into life, keep the commandments. He said unto him, Which? Jesus said, Thou shall do no murder, Thou shall not commit adultery, Thou shall not steal, Thou shall not bear false witness. Honor thy father and thy mother: and, Thou shall love thy neighbor as thyself. **Matthew 19:17-19.**

3. The basis of all good.

On these two commandments hang all the <u>law</u> and the prophets. Matthew 22:40

4. Keep the commandments

Thou know the **commandments**, Do not commit adultery, Do not kill, Do not steal, Do not bear false witness, Defraud not, Honor thy father and mother. **Mark 10:19**

5. Loyalty to God

And Jesus answered him, The first of all the commandments is, Hear, O Israel; The Lord our God is one Lord. Mark 12:29.

6. Blameless obedience

And they were both righteous before God, walking in all the commandments and ordinances of the Lord blameless. Luke 1:6

7. Keep the Ten Commandments

Thou know the **commandments**, Do not commit adultery, Do not kill, Do not steal, Do not bear false witness, Honor thy father and thy mother. Luke 18:20

8. If you love Jesus keep the Commandments.

If you love me, keep my commandments. John 14:15.

9. True love to God and Jesus

John 14:21 He that has my **commandments**, and keeps them, he it is that loves me: and he that loves me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him.

10. Jesus is our example and He kept the law of God.

If you keep my commandments, you shall abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father's commandments, and abide in his love. John 15:10.

11. The Sabbath still existed after Jesus died on the cross.

And that day was the preparation, and the Sabbath drew on. And the women also, which came with him from Galilee, followed after, and beheld the sepulcher, and how his body was laid. And they returned, and prepared spices and ointments; and rested the Sabbath day according to the commandment. **Luke 23:54-56.**

12. Doers of the law are just

12 For as many as have sinned without <u>law</u> shall also perish without <u>law</u>: and as many as have sinned in the <u>law</u> shall be judged by the <u>law</u>. 13 (For not the hearers of the <u>law</u> are just before God, but the doers of the <u>law</u> shall be justified. 14 For when the Gentiles, which have not the <u>law</u>, do by nature the things contained in the <u>law</u>, these, having not the <u>law</u>, are a <u>law</u> unto themselves. 15 Which show the work of the <u>law</u> written in their hearts, their conscience also bearing witness, and their thoughts the mean while accusing or else excusing one another. **Romans 2:12-15**

13. The law still existed after Calvary

17 Behold, you art called a Jew, and rests in the <u>law</u>, and makes thy boast of God, 18 And know his will, and approves the things that are more excellent, being instructed out of the <u>law</u>. Romans 2:17-18.

14. The law still existed after Calvary

20 An instructor of the foolish, a teacher of babes, which has the form of knowledge and of the truth in the <u>law</u>. 23 Thou that makes thy boast of the <u>law</u>, through breaking the <u>law</u> dishonors you God? Romans 2:20.

15. The definition of sin

3:19 Now we know that what things so ever the <u>law</u> said, it said to them who are under the <u>law</u>: that every mouth may be stopped, and all the world may become guilty before God. 3:20 Therefore by the deeds of the <u>law</u> there shall no flesh be justified in his sight: for by the <u>law</u> is the knowledge of sin. 21 But now the righteousness of God without the <u>law</u> is manifested, being witnessed by the <u>law</u> and the prophets; 27 Where is boasting then? It is excluded. By what <u>law</u>? Of works? Nay: but by the <u>law</u> of faith. Romans 3:19-27

16. We establish the law

3:28 Therefore we conclude that a man is justified by faith without the deeds of the <u>law</u>. 31 Do we then make void the <u>law</u> through faith? God forbid: yea, we establish the <u>law</u>. Romans 3:28, 31.

17. The definition of sin

Because the <u>law</u> works wrath: for where no <u>law</u> is, there is no transgression. Romans 4:15

18. The definition of good and evil

5:13 (For until the <u>law</u> sin was in the world: but sin is not imputed when there is no <u>law</u>.

19. The definition of sin

5:20 Moreover the law entered, that the offence might abound. But where sin abounded, grace did much more abound:

20. The definition of sin

6:14 For sin shall not have dominion over you: for you are not under the <u>law</u>, but under grace.

21. The definition of morality

7:1 Know you not, brethren, (for I speak to them that know the <u>law</u>,) how that the <u>law</u> has dominion over a man as long as he lives? 7:3 So then if, while her husband lives, she be married to another man, she shall be called an adulteress: but if her husband be dead, she is free from that <u>law</u>; so that she is no adulteress, though she be married to another man. **Romans 7:1-3.**

22. The definition of sin

What shall we say then? is the <u>law</u> sin? God forbid. Nay, I had not known sin, but by the <u>law</u>: for I had not known lust, except the <u>law</u> had said, Thou shall not covet. **Romans 7:7**

23. The law is holy

Wherefore the <u>law</u> is holy, and the commandment holy, and just, and good. Romans 7:12

24. The law is spiritual

For we know that the <u>law</u> is spiritual: but I am carnal, sold under sin. Romans 7:14

25. The law is good

If then I do that which I would not, I consent unto the \underline{law} that it is good. Romans 7:16

26. The law is a delight

For I delight in the <u>law</u> of God after the inward man: Romans 7:22

27. The law of God

I thank God through Jesus Christ our Lord. So then with the mind I myself serve the <u>law</u> of God; but with the flesh the <u>law</u> of sin. Romans 7:25

28. The law Ten Commandments

For this, Thou shall not commit adultery, Thou shall not kill, Thou shall not steal, Thou shall not bear false witness, Thou shall not covet; and if there be any other commandment, it is briefly comprehended in this saying, namely, Thou shall love thy neighbor as thyself. 10 Love works no ill to his neighbor: therefore love is the fulfilling of the law. Romans 13:9-10

29. Breaking the Commandments is Blasphemy

You therefore which teaches another, teaches you not thyself? You that preaches a man should not steal, do you steal? Thou that say a man should not commit adultery, do you commit adultery? You that abhors idols, do you commit sacrilege? You that make your boast of the <u>law</u>, through breaking the <u>law</u> dishonors God? For the name of God is blasphemed among the Gentiles through you, as it is written. **Romans 2:21-24**

30. Sin is the breaking of the law and existed since Adam and Eve.

Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned. For until the <u>law</u> sin was in the world: but sin is not imputed when there is no <u>law</u>. Nevertheless death reigned from Adam to Moses, even over them that had not sinned after the similitude of Adam's transgression, who is the figure of him that was to come. **Romans 5:13-15.**

31. The true Christian obeys the righteous law of God.

There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit. For the <u>law</u> of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the <u>law</u> of sin and death. For what the <u>law</u> could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh. That the righteousness of the <u>law</u> might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit. **Romans 8:1-4.**

32. The evil mind rejects keeping the commandments of God.

Because the carnal mind is enmity against God. For it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be. Romans 8:7.

33. True love is obeying the law of God.

Owe no man anything, but to love one another: for he that loves another hath fulfilled the <u>law</u>. For this, Thou shall not commit adultery, Thou shall not kill, Thou shall not steal, Thou shall not bear false witness, Thou shall not covet; and if there be any other commandment, it is briefly comprehended in this saying, namely, Thou shall love thy neighbor as thyself. Love works no ill to his neighbor: therefore love is the fulfilling of the <u>law</u>. And that, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep: for now is our salvation nearer than when we believed. **Romans 13:8-10.**

34. Keeping the Commandments is what really matters.

Circumcision is nothing, and un-circumcision is nothing, but the keeping of the commandments of God. 1 Corinthians 7:19.

35. Jesus gave the Ten Commandments at Mount Sinai.

Moreover, brethren, I would not that you should be ignorant, how that all our fathers were under the cloud, and all passed through the sea. And were all baptized unto Moses in the cloud and in the sea. And did all eat the same spiritual meat. And did all drink the same spiritual drink: for they drank of that spiritual Rock that followed them: and that Rock was Christ. **1 Corinthians 10:1-4**

36. The Ten Commandment Law is good in Paul's day.

But we know that the <u>law</u> is good, if a man use it lawfully. 1 Timothy 1:8

37. The Sabbath rest remains on the seventh day.

For he spoke in a certain place of the seventh day on this wise, And God did rest the seventh day from all his works. There remains therefore a rest [Greek - Sabbath] to the people of God. **Hebrews 4:4, 9.**

38. The Ten Commandment Law is part of the New Covenant.

For finding fault with them, he said, Behold, the days come, said the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah. Not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day when I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt; because they continued not in my covenant, and I regarded them not, said the Lord. For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, said the Lord; I will put my laws into their mind, and write them in their hearts: and I will be to them a God, and they shall be to me a people. **Hebrews 8:8-10.**

39. The who keep the law are blessed by God in what they do.

But they who look into the perfect <u>law</u> of liberty, and continue therein, they being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be blessed in his deed. **James 1:25.**

40. We will be judged by the Ten Commandments.

If you fulfill the royal <u>law</u> according to the scripture, Thou shall love thy neighbor as thyself, you do well. But if you have respect to persons, you commit sin, and are convinced of the <u>law</u> as transgressors. For whosoever shall keep the whole <u>law</u>, and yet offend in one point, he is guilty of all. For he that said, Do not commit adultery, said also, Do not kill. Now if thou commit no adultery, yet if thou kill, thou art become a transgressor of the <u>law</u>. So speak you, and so do, as they that shall be judged by the <u>law</u> of liberty. **James 2:8-12.**

41. We must keep the Commandments to know Jesus.

And hereby we do know that we know him, if we keep his commandments. He that said, I know him, and keeps not his commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him. But who so keeps his word, in him verily is the love of God perfected: hereby know we that we are in him. 1 John 2:3, 4.

42. We must keep the Commandments to abide in Jesus and the Holy Spirit.

And this is his commandment, That we should believe on the name of his Son Jesus Christ, and love one another, as he gave us commandment. And he that keeps his commandments dwells in him, and he in him. And hereby we know that he abides in us, by the Spirit which he hath given us. 1 John 3:22, 24.

43. Sin is transgression of the law.

Whosoever commits sin transgresses also the law: for sin is the transgression of the law. 1 John 3:4.

44. The love of God is to keep His Commandments.

By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God, and keep his commandments. For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments: and his commandments are not grievous. 1 John 5:2, 3.

45. The Ark of the Ten Commandment Covenant still in heaven.

And the temple of God was opened in heaven, and there was seen in his temple the ark of his testament. And there were lightning, and voices, and thundering, and an earthquake, and great hail. **Revelation 11:19.**

46. The Ark of the Ten Commandment Covenant still in heaven.

And after that I looked, and, behold, the temple of the tabernacle of the testimony in heaven was opened. Revelation 15:5.

47. God's saints keep the commandments.

And the dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with the remnant of her seed, which keep the commandments of God, and have the testimony of Jesus Christ. **Revelation 12:17.**

48. God's saints keep the commandments.

Here is the patience of the saints: here [are] they that keep the commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus. Revelation 14:12.

49. Commandment breakers cast into the Lake of Fire.

But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whore mongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burns with fire and brimstone: which is the second death. **Revelation 21:8.**

50. God's saints keep the commandments.

Blessed are they that do his commandments, that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city. **Revelation 22:14.**

51. Lawless people are excluded from the Paradise of God.

For without are dogs, and sorcerers, and whore mongers, and murderers, and idolaters, and whosoever loves and makes a lie. **Revelation 22:15.**
