And Laban searched all the tent, but found them not. **35** And she said to her father, Let it not displease my lord that I cannot rise up before you; for the custom of women is upon me. And he searched, but found not the images. **36** And Jacob was wroth, and chided with Laban: and Jacob answered and said to Laban, What is my trespass? what is my sin, that you has so hotly pursued after me? **Genesis 31:19, 30-36**
