The Ten Commandments

Exodus 20:2-17

1

I am the LORD thy God, which have brought thee out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage. 2

Thou shalt have no other gods before me. 3

2

Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of any thing that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth: 4 Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate me; 5 And showing mercy unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments. 6

Thou shalt not take the name of the LORD thy God in vain; for the LORD will not hold him guiltless that taketh his name in vain. 7

Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy. 8 Six days shalt thou labor, and do all thy work: 9 But the seventh day is the sabbath of the LORD thy God: in it thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that is within thy gates: 10 For in six days the LORD made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them is, and rested the seventh day: wherefore the LORD blessed the sabbath day, and hallowed it. 11

Honor thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee. 12

The Heavenly Sanctuary

Which had the golden censer, and the <u>ark</u> of the covenant overlaid round about with gold, wherein was the golden pot that had manna, and Aaron's rod that budded, and the <u>tables</u> of the covenant; Hebrews 9:4

And the temple of God was opened in heaven, and there was seen in his temple the <u>ark</u> of his <u>testament</u>: and there were lightnings, and voices, and thunderings, and an earthquake, and great hail. Revelation 11:19

And after that I looked, and, behold, the temple of the tabernacle of the testimony in heaven was opened: Revelation 15:5

Testament

For this is my blood of the new **testament**, which is shed for many for the remission of sins. Matthew 26:28

And he said unto them, This is my blood of the new testament, which is shed for many. Mark 14:24

Likewise also the cup after supper, saying, This cup is the new **testament** in my blood, which is shed for you. Luke 22:20

After the same manner also he took the cup, when he had supped, saying, This cup is the new **testament** in my blood: this do ye, as oft as ye drink it, in remembrance of me. 1 Corinthians 11:25

By so much was Jesus made a surety of a better **testament**. Hebrews 7:22

And for this cause he is the mediator of the new <u>testament</u>, that by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions that were under the first <u>testament</u>, they which are called might receive the promise of eternal inheritance. Hebrews 9:15

For where a testament is, there must also of necessity be the death of the testator. Hebrews 9:16

For a **testament** is of force after men are dead: otherwise it is of no strength at all while the testator liveth. Hebrews 9:17

Whereupon neither the first **testament** was dedicated without blood. Hebrews 9:18

Saying, This is the blood of the **testament** which God hath enjoined unto you. Hebrews 9:20

And the temple of God was opened in heaven, and there was seen in his temple the <u>ark</u> of his <u>testament</u>: and there were lightnings, and voices, and thunderings, and an earthquake, and great hail. Revelation 11:19

Testimony

As the LORD commanded Moses, so Aaron laid it up before the **Testimony**, to be kept. Exodus 16:34

And thou shalt put into the **ark** the **testimony** which I shall give thee. Exodus 25:16

And thou shalt put the mercy seat above upon the <u>ark</u>; and in the <u>ark</u> thou shalt put the <u>testimony</u> that I shall give thee. Exodus 25:21 And there I will meet with thee, and I will commune with thee from above the mercy seat, from between the two cherubims which are upon the <u>ark</u> of the <u>testimony</u>, of all things which I will give thee in commandment unto the children of Israel. Exodus 25:22

And thou shalt hang up the veil under the taches, that thou mayest bring in thither within the veil the \underline{ark} of the $\underline{testimony}$: and the veil shall divide unto you between the holy place and the most holy. Exodus 26:33

And thou shalt put the mercy seat upon the <u>ark</u> of the <u>testimony</u> in the most holy place. Exodus 26:34

In the tabernacle of the congregation without the veil, which is before the <u>testimony</u>, Aaron and his sons shall order it from evening to morning before the LORD: it shall be a statute for ever unto their generations on the behalf of the children of Israel. Exodus 27:21 And thou shalt put it before the veil that is by the <u>ark</u> of the <u>testimony</u>, before the mercy seat that is over the <u>testimony</u>, where I will meet with thee. Exodus 30:6

And thou shalt anoint the tabernacle of the congregation therewith, and the ark of the testimony, Exodus 30:26

And thou shalt beat some of it very small, and put of it before the <u>testimony</u> in the tabernacle of the congregation, where I will meet with thee: it shall be unto you most holy. Exodus 30:36

The tabernacle of the congregation, and the <u>ark</u> of the <u>testimony</u>, and the mercy seat that is thereupon, and all the furniture of the tabernacle, Exodus 31:7

And he gave unto Moses, when he had made an end of communing with him upon mount Sinai, two <u>tables</u> of <u>testimony</u>, <u>tables</u> of stone, written with the finger of God. Exodus 31:18

And Moses turned, and went down from the mount, and the two <u>tables</u> of the <u>testimony</u> were in his hand: the <u>tables</u> were written on both their sides; on the one side and on the other were they written. Exodus 32:15

And it came to pass, when Moses came down from mount Sinai with the two <u>tables</u> of <u>testimony</u> in Moses' hand, when he came down from the mount, that Moses wist not that the skin of his face shone while he talked with him. Exodus 34:29

This is the sum of the tabernacle, even of the tabernacle of **testimony**, as it was counted, according to the commandment of Moses, for the service of the Levites, by the hand of Ithamar, son to Aaron the priest. Exodus 38:21

The ark of the testimony, and the staves thereof, and the mercy seat, Exodus 39:35

And thou shalt put therein the <u>ark</u> of the <u>testimony</u>, and cover the <u>ark</u> with the veil. Exodus 40:3

And thou shalt set the altar of gold for the incense before the <u>ark</u> of the <u>testimony</u>, and put the hanging of the door to the tabernacle. Exodus 40:5

And he took and put the <u>testimony</u> into the <u>ark</u>, and set the staves on the <u>ark</u>, and put the mercy seat above upon the <u>ark</u>: Exodus 40:20

And he brought the <u>ark</u> into the tabernacle, and set up the veil of the covering, and covered the <u>ark</u> of the <u>testimony</u>; as the LORD commanded Moses. Exodus 40:21

And he shall put the incense upon the fire before the LORD, that the cloud of the incense may cover the mercy seat that is upon the **testimony**, that he die not: Leviticus 16:13

Without the veil of the <u>testimony</u>, in the tabernacle of the congregation, shall Aaron order it from the evening unto the morning before the LORD continually: it shall be a statute for ever in your generations. Leviticus 24:3

But thou shalt appoint the Levites over the tabernacle of <u>testimony</u>, and over all the vessels thereof, and over all things that belong to it: they shall bear the tabernacle, and all the vessels thereof; and they shall minister unto it, and shall encamp round about the tabernacle. Numbers 1:50

But the Levites shall pitch round about the tabernacle of <u>testimony</u>, that there be no wrath upon the congregation of the children of Israel: and the Levites shall keep the charge of the tabernacle of **testimony**. Numbers 1:53

And when the camp setteth forward, Aaron shall come, and his sons, and they shall take down the covering veil, and cover the **ark** of **testimony** with it: Numbers 4:5

And when Moses was gone into the tabernacle of the congregation to speak with him, then he heard the voice of one speaking unto him from off the mercy seat that was upon the <u>ark</u> of <u>testimony</u>, from between the two cherubims: and he spake unto him. Numbers 7:89

And on the day that the tabernacle was reared up the cloud covered the tabernacle, namely, the tent of the **testimony**: and at even there was upon the tabernacle as it were the appearance of fire, until the morning. Numbers 9:15

And it came to pass on the twentieth day of the second month, in the second year, that the cloud was taken up from off the tabernacle of the **testimony**. Numbers 10:11

And thou shalt lay them up in the tabernacle of the congregation before the <u>testimony</u>, where I will meet with you. Numbers 17:4 And the LORD said unto Moses, Bring Aaron's rod again before the <u>testimony</u>, to be kept for a token against the rebels; and thou shalt quite take away their murmurings from me, that they die not. Numbers 17:10

Command the priests that bear the ark of the testimony, that they come up out of Jordan. Joshua 4:16

The law of the LORD is perfect, converting the soul: the **testimony** of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple. Psalms 19:7

Ye shall diligently keep the commandments of the LORD your God, and his <u>testimonies</u>, and his statutes, which he hath commanded thee. Deuteronomy 6:17

And when thy son asketh thee in time to come, saying, What mean the <u>testimonies</u>, and the statutes, and the judgments, which the LORD our God hath commanded you? Deuteronomy 6:20

And keep the charge of the LORD thy God, to walk in his ways, to keep his statutes, and his commandments, and his judgments, and his <u>testimonies</u>, as it is written in the law of Moses, that thou mayest prosper in all that thou doest, and whithersoever thou turnest thyself: 1 Kings 2:3

And they rejected his statutes, and his covenant that he made with their fathers, and his <u>testimonies</u> which he testified against them; and they followed vanity, and became vain, and went after the heathen that were round about them, concerning whom the LORD had charged them, that they should not do like them. 2 Kings 17:15

And the king stood by a pillar, and made a covenant before the LORD, to walk after the LORD, and to keep his commandments and his **testimonies** and his statutes with all their heart and all their soul, to perform the words of this covenant that were written in this book. Ark Of The Covenant

And they shall make an <u>ark</u> of shittim wood: two cubits and a half shall be the length thereof, and a cubit and a half the breadth thereof, and a cubit and a half the height thereof. Exodus 25:10

And thou shalt put the staves into the rings by the sides of the <u>ark</u>, that the <u>ark</u> may be borne with them. Exodus 25:14

The staves shall be in the rings of the **ark**: they shall not be taken from it. Exodus 25:15

And thou shalt put into the **ark** the testimony which I shall give thee. Exodus 25:16

And thou shalt put the mercy seat above upon the <u>ark</u>; and in the <u>ark</u> thou shalt put the testimony that I shall give thee. Exodus 25:21 And there I will meet with thee, and I will commune with thee from above the mercy seat, from between the two cherubims which are upon the <u>ark</u> of the testimony, of all things which I will give thee in commandment unto the children of Israel. Exodus 25:22

And thou shalt hang up the veil under the taches, that thou mayest bring in thither within the veil the <u>ark</u> of the testimony: and the veil shall divide unto you between the holy place and the most holy. Exodus 26:33

And thou shalt put the mercy seat upon the ark of the testimony in the most holy place. Exodus 26:34

And thou shalt put it before the veil that is by the <u>ark</u> of the testimony, before the mercy seat that is over the testimony, where I will meet with thee. Exodus 30:6

And Bezaleel made the <u>ark</u> of shittim wood: two cubits and a half was the length of it, and a cubit and a half the breadth of it, and a cubit and a half the height of it: Exodus 37:1

And he put the staves into the rings by the sides of the <u>ark</u>, to bear the <u>ark</u>. Exodus 37:5

The <u>ark</u> of the testimony, and the staves thereof, and the mercy seat, Exodus 39:35

And thou shalt put therein the **ark** of the testimony, and cover the **ark** with the veil. Exodus 40:3

And thou shalt set the altar of gold for the incense before the <u>ark</u> of the testimony, and put the hanging of the door to the tabernacle.

And he took and put the testimony into the \underline{ark} , and set the staves on the \underline{ark} , and put the mercy seat above upon the \underline{ark} : Exodus 40:20

And he brought the \underline{ark} into the tabernacle, and set up the veil of the covering, and covered the \underline{ark} of the testimony; as the LORD commanded Moses. Exodus 40:21

And the LORD said unto Moses, Speak unto Aaron thy brother, that he come not at all times into the holy place within the veil before the mercy seat, which is upon the **ark**; that he die not: for I will appear in the cloud upon the mercy seat. Leviticus 16:2

And their charge shall be the <u>ark</u>, and the table, and the candlestick, and the altars, and the vessels of the sanctuary wherewith they minister, and the hanging, and all the service thereof. Numbers 3:31

And when the camp setteth forward, Aaron shall come, and his sons, and they shall take down the covering veil, and cover the <u>ark</u> of testimony with it: Numbers 4:5

And when Moses was gone into the tabernacle of the congregation to speak with him, then he heard the voice of one speaking unto him from off the mercy seat that was upon the <u>ark</u> of testimony, from between the two cherubims: and he spake unto him. Numbers 7:89

And they departed from the mount of the LORD three days' journey: and the <u>ark</u> of the covenant of the LORD went before them in the three days' journey, to search out a resting place for them. Numbers 10:33

And it came to pass, when the <u>ark</u> set forward, that Moses said, Rise up, LORD, and let thine enemies be scattered; and let them that hate thee flee before thee. Numbers 10:35

But they presumed to go up unto the hill top: nevertheless the <u>ark</u> of the covenant of the LORD, and Moses, departed not out of the camp. Numbers 14:44

At that time the LORD said unto me, Hew thee two <u>tables</u> of stone like unto the first, and come up unto me into the mount, and make thee an <u>ark</u> of wood. Deuteronomy 10:1

And I will write on the <u>tables</u> the words that were in the first <u>tables</u> which thou brakest, and thou shalt put them in the <u>ark</u>. Deuteronomy 10:2

And I made an <u>ark</u> of shittim wood, and hewed two <u>tables</u> of stone like unto the first, and went up into the mount, having the two <u>tables</u> in mine hand. Deuteronomy 10:3

And I turned myself and came down from the mount, and put the <u>tables</u> in the <u>ark</u> which I had made; and there they be, as the LORD commanded me. Deuteronomy 10:5

At that time the LORD separated the tribe of Levi, to bear the <u>ark</u> of the covenant of the LORD, to stand before the LORD to minister unto him, and to bless in his name, unto this day. Deuteronomy 10:8

And Moses wrote this law, and delivered it unto the priests the sons of Levi, which bare the <u>ark</u> of the covenant of the LORD, and unto all the elders of Israel. Deuteronomy 31:9

That Moses commanded the Levites, which bare the ark of the covenant of the LORD, saying, Deuteronomy 31:25

Take this book of the law, and put it in the side of the <u>ark</u> of the covenant of the LORD your God, that it may be there for a witness against thee. Deuteronomy 31:26

And they commanded the people, saying, When ye see the <u>ark</u> of the covenant of the LORD your God, and the priests the Levites bearing it, then ye shall remove from your place, and go after it. Joshua 3:3

And Joshua spake unto the priests, saying, Take up the <u>ark</u> of the covenant, and pass over before the people. And they took up the <u>ark</u> of the covenant, and went before the people. Joshua 3:6

And thou shalt command the priests that bear the <u>ark</u> of the covenant, saying, When ye are come to the brink of the water of Jordan, ye shall stand still in Jordan. Joshua 3:8

Behold, the ark of the covenant of the LORD of all the earth passeth over before you into Jordan. Joshua 3:11

And it shall come to pass, as soon as the soles of the feet of the priests that bear the <u>ark</u> of the LORD, the Lord of all the earth, shall rest in the waters of Jordan, that the waters of Jordan shall be cut off from the waters that come down from above; and they shall stand upon an heap. Joshua 3:13

And it came to pass, when the people removed from their tents, to pass over Jordan, and the priests bearing the <u>ark</u> of the covenant before the people; Joshua 3:14

And as they that bare the <u>ark</u> were come unto Jordan, and the feet of the priests that bare the <u>ark</u> were dipped in the brim of the water, (for Jordan overfloweth all his banks all the time of harvest,) Joshua 3:15

And the priests that bare the <u>ark</u> of the covenant of the LORD stood firm on dry ground in the midst of Jordan, and all the Israelites passed over on dry ground, until all the people were passed clean over Jordan. Joshua 3:17

And Joshua said unto them, Pass over before the <u>ark</u> of the LORD your God into the midst of Jordan, and take you up every man of you a stone upon his shoulder, according unto the number of the tribes of the children of Israel: Joshua 4:5

Then ye shall answer them, That the waters of Jordan were cut off before the <u>ark</u> of the covenant of the LORD; when it passed over Jordan, the waters of Jordan were cut off: and these stones shall be for a memorial unto the children of Israel for ever. Joshua 4:7

And Joshua set up twelve stones in the midst of Jordan, in the place where the feet of the priests which bare the <u>ark</u> of the covenant stood: and they are there unto this day. Joshua 4:9

For the priests which bare the <u>ark</u> stood in the midst of Jordan, until every thing was finished that the LORD commanded Joshua to speak unto the people, according to all that Moses commanded Joshua: and the people hasted and passed over. Joshua 4:10

And it came to pass, when all the people were clean passed over, that the <u>ark</u> of the LORD passed over, and the priests, in the presence of the people. Joshua 4:11

Command the priests that bear the ark of the testimony, that they come up out of Jordan. Joshua 4:16

And it came to pass, when the priests that bare the <u>ark</u> of the covenant of the LORD were come up out of the midst of Jordan, and the soles of the priests' feet were lifted up unto the dry land, that the waters of Jordan returned unto their place, and flowed over all his banks, as they did before. Joshua 4:18

And seven priests shall bear before the <u>ark</u> seven trumpets of rams' horns: and the seventh day ye shall compass the city seven times, and the priests shall blow with the trumpets. Joshua 6:4

And Joshua the son of Nun called the priests, and said unto them, Take up the <u>ark</u> of the covenant, and let seven priests bear seven trumpets of rams' horns before the **ark** of the LORD. Joshua 6:6

And he said unto the people, Pass on, and compass the city, and let him that is armed pass on before the <u>ark</u> of the LORD. Joshua 6:7 And it came to pass, when Joshua had spoken unto the people, that the seven priests bearing the seven trumpets of rams' horns passed on before the LORD, and blew with the trumpets: and the **ark** of the covenant of the LORD followed them. Joshua 6:8

And the armed men went before the priests that blew with the trumpets, and the rereward came after the <u>ark</u>, the priests going on, and blowing with the trumpets. Joshua 6:9

So the <u>ark</u> of the LORD compassed the city, going about it once: and they came into the camp, and lodged in the camp. Joshua 6:11 And Joshua rose early in the morning, and the priests took up the <u>ark</u> of the LORD. Joshua 6:12

And seven priests bearing seven trumpets of rams' horns before the <u>ark</u> of the LORD went on continually, and blew with the trumpets: and the armed men went before them; but the rereward came after the <u>ark</u> of the LORD, the priests going on, and blowing with the trumpets. Joshua 6:13

And Joshua rent his clothes, and fell to the earth upon his face before the \underline{ark} of the LORD until the eventide, he and the elders of Israel, and put dust upon their heads. Joshua 7:6

And all Israel, and their elders, and officers, and their judges, stood on this side the <u>ark</u> and on that side before the priests the Levites, which bare the <u>ark</u> of the covenant of the LORD, as well the stranger, as he that was born among them; half of them over against mount Gerizim, and half of them over against mount Ebal; as Moses the servant of the LORD had commanded before, that they should bless the people of Israel. Joshua 8:33

And the children of Israel inquired of the LORD, (for the ark of the covenant of God was there in those days, Judges 20:27

And ere the lamp of God went out in the temple of the LORD, where the <u>ark</u> of God was, and Samuel was laid down to sleep; 1 Samuel 3:3

And when the people were come into the camp, the elders of Israel said, Wherefore hath the LORD smitten us to day before the Philistines? Let us fetch the <u>ark</u> of the covenant of the LORD out of Shiloh unto us, that, when it cometh among us, it may save us out of the hand of our enemies. 1 Samuel 4:3

So the people sent to Shiloh, that they might bring from thence the <u>ark</u> of the covenant of the LORD of hosts, which dwelleth between the cherubims: and the two sons of Eli, Hophni and Phinehas, were there with the **ark** of the covenant of God. 1 Samuel 4:4

And when the <u>ark</u> of the covenant of the LORD came into the camp, all Israel shouted with a great shout, so that the earth rang again. 1 Samuel 4:5

And when the Philistines heard the noise of the shout, they said, What meaneth the noise of this great shout in the camp of the Hebrews? And they understood that the **ark** of the LORD was come into the camp. 1 Samuel 4:6

And the ark of God was taken; and the two sons of Eli, Hophni and Phinehas, were slain. 1 Samuel 4:11

And when he came, lo, Eli sat upon a seat by the wayside watching: for his heart trembled for the <u>ark</u> of God. And when the man came into the city, and told it, all the city cried out. 1 Samuel 4:13

And the messenger answered and said, Israel is fled before the Philistines, and there hath been also a great slaughter among the people, and thy two sons also, Hophni and Phinehas, are dead, and the **ark** of God is taken. 1 Samuel 4:17

And it came to pass, when he made mention of the <u>ark</u> of God, that he fell from off the seat backward by the side of the gate, and his neck brake, and he died: for he was an old man, and heavy. And he had judged Israel forty years. 1 Samuel 4:18

And his daughter in law, Phinehas' wife, was with child, near to be delivered: and when she heard the tidings that the <u>ark</u> of God was taken, and that her father in law and her husband were dead, she bowed herself and travailed; for her pains came upon her. 1 Samuel 4:19

And she named the child Ichabod, saying, The glory is departed from Israel: because the <u>ark</u> of God was taken, and because of her father in law and her husband. 1 Samuel 4:21

And she said, The glory is departed from Israel: for the ark of God is taken. 1 Samuel 4:22

And the Philistines took the ark of God, and brought it from Ebenezer unto Ashdod. 1 Samuel 5:1

When the Philistines took the ark of God, they brought it into the house of Dagon, and set it by Dagon. 1 Samuel 5:2

And when they of Ashdod arose early on the morrow, behold, Dagon was fallen upon his face to the earth before the <u>ark</u> of the LORD. And they took Dagon, and set him in his place again. 1 Samuel 5:3

And when they arose early on the morrow morning, behold, Dagon was fallen upon his face to the ground before the <u>ark</u> of the LORD; and the head of Dagon and both the palms of his hands were cut off upon the threshold; only the stump of Dagon was left to him. 1 Samuel 5:4

And when the men of Ashdod saw that it was so, they said, The <u>ark</u> of the God of Israel shall not abide with us: for his hand is sore upon us, and upon Dagon our god. 1 Samuel 5:7

They sent therefore and gathered all the lords of the Philistines unto them, and said, What shall we do with the <u>ark</u> of the God of Israel? And they answered, Let the <u>ark</u> of the God of Israel be carried about unto Gath. And they carried the <u>ark</u> of the God of Israel about thither. 1 Samuel 5:8

Therefore they sent the <u>ark</u> of God to Ekron. And it came to pass, as the <u>ark</u> of God came to Ekron, that the Ekronites cried out, saying, They have brought about the <u>ark</u> of the God of Israel to us, to slay us and our people. 1 Samuel 5:10

So they sent and gathered together all the lords of the Philistines, and said, Send away the <u>ark</u> of the God of Israel, and let it go again to his own place, that it slay us not, and our people: for there was a deadly destruction throughout all the city; the hand of God was very heavy there. 1 Samuel 5:11

And the ark of the LORD was in the country of the Philistines seven months. 1 Samuel 6:1

And the Philistines called for the priests and the diviners, saying, What shall we do to the <u>ark</u> of the LORD? tell us wherewith we shall send it to his place. 1 Samuel 6:2

And they said, If ye send away the <u>ark</u> of the God of Israel, send it not empty; but in any wise return him a trespass offering: then ye shall be healed, and it shall be known to you why his hand is not removed from you. 1 Samuel 6:3

And take the <u>ark</u> of the LORD, and lay it upon the cart; and put the jewels of gold, which ye return him for a trespass offering, in a coffer by the side thereof; and send it away, that it may go. 1 Samuel 6:8

And they laid the <u>ark</u> of the LORD upon the cart, and the coffer with the mice of gold and the images of their emerods. 1 Samuel 6:11 And they of Bethshemesh were reaping their wheat harvest in the valley: and they lifted up their eyes, and saw the <u>ark</u>, and rejoiced to see it. 1 Samuel 6:13

And the Levites took down the <u>ark</u> of the LORD, and the coffer that was with it, wherein the jewels of gold were, and put them on the great stone: and the men of Bethshemesh offered burnt offerings and sacrificed sacrifices the same day unto the LORD. 1 Samuel 6:15 And the golden mice, according to the number of all the cities of the Philistines belonging to the five lords, both of fenced cities, and of country villages, even unto the great stone of Abel, whereon they set down the <u>ark</u> of the LORD: which stone remaineth unto this day in the field of Joshua, the Bethshemite. 1 Samuel 6:18

And he smote the men of Bethshemesh, because they had looked into the <u>ark</u> of the LORD, even he smote of the people fifty thousand and threescore and ten men: and the people lamented, because the LORD had smitten many of the people with a great slaughter. 1 Samuel 6:19

And they sent messengers to the inhabitants of Kirjathjearim, saying, The Philistines have brought again the <u>ark</u> of the LORD; come ye down, and fetch it up to you. 1 Samuel 6:21

And the men of Kirjathjearim came, and fetched up the <u>ark</u> of the LORD, and brought it into the house of Abinadab in the hill, and sanctified Eleazar his son to keep the **ark** of the LORD. 1 Samuel 7:1

And it came to pass, while the <u>ark</u> abode in Kirjathjearim, that the time was long; for it was twenty years: and all the house of Israel lamented after the LORD. 1 Samuel 7:2

And Saul said unto Ahiah, Bring hither the <u>ark</u> of God. For the <u>ark</u> of God was at that time with the children of Israel. 1 Samuel 14:18

And David arose, and went with all the people that were with him from Baale of Judah, to bring up from thence the <u>ark</u> of God, whose name is called by the name of the LORD of hosts that dwelleth between the cherubims. 2 Samuel 6:2

And they set the <u>ark</u> of God upon a new cart, and brought it out of the house of Abinadab that was in Gibeah: and Uzzah and Ahio, the sons of Abinadab, drave the new cart. 2 Samuel 6:3

And they brought it out of the house of Abinadab which was at Gibeah, accompanying the <u>ark</u> of God: and Ahio went before the <u>ark</u>. 2 Samuel 6:4

And when they came to Nachon's threshingfloor, Uzzah put forth his hand to the <u>ark</u> of God, and took hold of it; for the oxen shook it. 2 Samuel 6:6

And the anger of the LORD was kindled against Uzzah; and God smote him there for his error; and there he died by the \underline{ark} of God. 2 Samuel 6:7

And David was afraid of the LORD that day, and said, How shall the ark of the LORD come to me? 2 Samuel 6:9

So David would not remove the <u>ark</u> of the LORD unto him into the city of David: but David carried it aside into the house of Obededom the Gittite. 2 Samuel 6:10

And the <u>ark</u> of the LORD continued in the house of Obededom the Gittite three months: and the LORD blessed Obededom, and all his household. 2 Samuel 6:11

And it was told king David, saying, The LORD hath blessed the house of Obededom, and all that pertaineth unto him, because of the <u>ark</u> of God. So David went and brought up the <u>ark</u> of God from the house of Obededom into the city of David with gladness. 2 Samuel 6:12

And it was so, that when they that bare the ark of the LORD had gone six paces, he sacrificed oxen and fatlings. 2 Samuel 6:13

So David and all the house of Israel brought up the <u>ark</u> of the LORD with shouting, and with the sound of the trumpet. 2 Samuel 6:15 And as the <u>ark</u> of the LORD came into the city of David, Michal Saul's daughter looked through a window, and saw king David leaping and dancing before the LORD; and she despised him in her heart. 2 Samuel 6:16

And they brought in the <u>ark</u> of the LORD, and set it in his place, in the midst of the tabernacle that David had pitched for it: and David offered burnt offerings and peace offerings before the LORD. 2 Samuel 6:17

That the king said unto Nathan the prophet, See now, I dwell in an house of cedar, but the <u>ark</u> of God dwelleth within curtains. 2 Samuel 7:2

And Uriah said unto David, The <u>ark</u>, and Israel, and Judah, abide in tents; and my lord Joab, and the servants of my lord, are encamped in the open fields; shall I then go into mine house, to eat and to drink, and to lie with my wife? as thou livest, and as thy soul liveth, I will not do this thing. 2 Samuel 11:11

And lo Zadok also, and all the Levites were with him, bearing the <u>ark</u> of the covenant of God: and they set down the <u>ark</u> of God; and Abiathar went up, until all the people had done passing out of the city. 2 Samuel 15:24

And the king said unto Zadok, Carry back the <u>ark</u> of God into the city: if I shall find favour in the eyes of the LORD, he will bring me again, and show me both it, and his habitation: 2 Samuel 15:25

Zadok therefore and Abiathar carried the ark of God again to Jerusalem: and they tarried there. 2 Samuel 15:29

And unto Abiathar the priest said the king, Get thee to Anathoth, unto thine own fields; for thou art worthy of death: but I will not at this time put thee to death, because thou barest the <u>ark</u> of the Lord GOD before David my father, and because thou hast been afflicted in all wherein my father was afflicted. 1 Kings 2:26

And Solomon awoke; and, behold, it was a dream. And he came to Jerusalem, and stood before the <u>ark</u> of the covenant of the LORD, and offered up burnt offerings, and offered peace offerings, and made a feast to all his servants. 1 Kings 3:15

And the oracle he prepared in the house within, to set there the ark of the covenant of the LORD. 1 Kings 6:19

Then Solomon assembled the elders of Israel, and all the heads of the tribes, the chief of the fathers of the children of Israel, unto king Solomon in Jerusalem, that they might bring up the <u>ark</u> of the covenant of the LORD out of the city of David, which is Zion. 1 Kings 8·1

And all the elders of Israel came, and the priests took up the <u>ark</u>. 1 Kings 8:3

And they brought up the <u>ark</u> of the LORD, and the tabernacle of the congregation, and all the holy vessels that were in the tabernacle, even those did the priests and the Levites bring up. 1 Kings 8:4

And king Solomon, and all the congregation of Israel, that were assembled unto him, were with him before the <u>ark</u>, sacrificing sheep and oxen, that could not be told nor numbered for multitude. 1 Kings 8:5

And the priests brought in the <u>ark</u> of the covenant of the LORD unto his place, into the oracle of the house, to the most holy place, even under the wings of the cherubims. 1 Kings 8:6

For the cherubims spread forth their two wings over the place of the <u>ark</u>, and the cherubims covered the <u>ark</u> and the staves thereof above. 1 Kings 8:7

There was nothing in the <u>ark</u> save the two <u>tables</u> of stone, which Moses put there at Horeb, when the LORD made a covenant with the children of Israel, when they came out of the land of Egypt. 1 Kings 8:9

And I have set there a place for the <u>ark</u>, wherein is the covenant of the LORD, which he made with our fathers, when he brought them out of the land of Egypt. 1 Kings 8:21

And these are they whom David set over the service of song in the house of the LORD, after that the ark had rest. 1 Chronicles 6:31

And let us bring again the ark of our God to us: for we inquired not at it in the days of Saul. 1 Chronicles 13:3

So David gathered all Israel together, from Shihor of Egypt even unto the entering of Hemath, to bring the <u>ark</u> of God from Kirjathjearim. 1 Chronicles 13:5

And David went up, and all Israel, to Baalah, that is, to Kirjathjearim, which belonged to Judah, to bring up thence the <u>ark</u> of God the LORD, that dwelleth between the cherubims, whose name is called on it. 1 Chronicles 13:6

And they carried the ark of God in a new cart out of the house of Abinadab: and Uzza and Ahio drave the cart. 1 Chronicles 13:7

And when they came unto the threshingfloor of Chidon, Uzza put forth his hand to hold the <u>ark;</u> for the oxen stumbled. 1 Chronicles 13:9

And the anger of the LORD was kindled against Uzza, and he smote him, because he put his hand to the <u>ark</u>: and there he died before God. 1 Chronicles 13:10

And David was afraid of God that day, saying, How shall I bring the ark of God home to me? 1 Chronicles 13:12

So David brought not the <u>ark</u> home to himself to the city of David, but carried it aside into the house of Obededom the Gittite. 1 Chronicles 13:13

And the <u>ark</u> of God remained with the family of Obededom in his house three months. And the LORD blessed the house of Obededom, and all that he had. 1 Chronicles 13:14

And David made him houses in the city of David, and prepared a place for the <u>ark</u> of God, and pitched for it a tent. 1 Chronicles 15:1

Then David said, None ought to carry the <u>ark</u> of God but the Levites: for them hath the LORD chosen to carry the <u>ark</u> of God, and to minister unto him for ever. 1 Chronicles 15:2

And David gathered all Israel together to Jerusalem, to bring up the <u>ark</u> of the LORD unto his place, which he had prepared for it. 1 Chronicles 15:3

And said unto them, Ye are the chief of the fathers of the Levites: sanctify yourselves, both ye and your brethren, that ye may bring up the **ark** of the LORD God of Israel unto the place that I have prepared for it. 1 Chronicles 15:12

So the priests and the Levites sanctified themselves to bring up the ark of the LORD God of Israel. 1 Chronicles 15:14

And the children of the Levites bare the \underline{ark} of God upon their shoulders with the staves thereon, as Moses commanded according to the word of the LORD. 1 Chronicles 15:15

And Berechiah and Elkanah were doorkeepers for the ark. 1 Chronicles 15:23

And Shebaniah, and Jehoshaphat, and Nethaneel, and Amasai, and Zechariah, and Benaiah, and Eliezer, the priests, did blow with the trumpets before the <u>ark</u> of God: and Obededom and Jehiah were doorkeepers for the <u>ark</u>. 1 Chronicles 15:24

So David, and the elders of Israel, and the captains over thousands, went to bring up the <u>ark</u> of the covenant of the LORD out of the house of Obededom with joy. 1 Chronicles 15:25

And it came to pass, when God helped the Levites that bare the <u>ark</u> of the covenant of the LORD, that they offered seven bullocks and seven rams. 1 Chronicles 15:26

And David was clothed with a robe of fine linen, and all the Levites that bare the <u>ark</u>, and the singers, and Chenaniah the master of the song with the singers: David also had upon him an ephod of linen. 1 Chronicles 15:27

Thus all Israel brought up the <u>ark</u> of the covenant of the LORD with shouting, and with sound of the cornet, and with trumpets, and with cymbals, making a noise with psalteries and harps. 1 Chronicles 15:28

And it came to pass, as the <u>ark</u> of the covenant of the LORD came to the city of David, that Michal the daughter of Saul looking out at a window saw king David dancing and playing: and she despised him in her heart. 1 Chronicles 15:29

So they brought the <u>ark</u> of God, and set it in the midst of the tent that David had pitched for it: and they offered burnt sacrifices and peace offerings before God. 1 Chronicles 16:1

And he appointed certain of the Levites to minister before the <u>ark</u> of the LORD, and to record, and to thank and praise the LORD God of Israel: 1 Chronicles 16:4

Benaiah also and Jahaziel the priests with trumpets continually before the ark of the covenant of God. 1 Chronicles 16:6

So he left there before the <u>ark</u> of the covenant of the LORD Asaph and his brethren, to minister before the <u>ark</u> continually, as every day's work required: 1 Chronicles 16:37

Now it came to pass, as David sat in his house, that David said to Nathan the prophet, Lo, I dwell in an house of cedars, but the <u>ark</u> of the covenant of the LORD remaineth under curtains. 1 Chronicles 17:1

Now set your heart and your soul to seek the LORD your God; arise therefore, and build ye the sanctuary of the LORD God, to bring the \underline{ark} of the covenant of the LORD, and the holy vessels of God, into the house that is to be built to the name of the LORD. 1 Chronicles 22:19

Then David the king stood up upon his feet, and said, Hear me, my brethren, and my people: As for me, I had in mine heart to build an house of rest for the <u>ark</u> of the covenant of the LORD, and for the footstool of our God, and had made ready for the building: 1 Chronicles 28:2

And for the altar of incense refined gold by weight; and gold for the pattern of the chariot of the cherubims, that spread out their wings, and covered the ark of the covenant of the LORD. 1 Chronicles 28:18

But the <u>ark</u> of God had David brought up from Kirjathjearim to the place which David had prepared for it: for he had pitched a tent for it at Jerusalem. 2 Chronicles 1:4

Then Solomon assembled the elders of Israel, and all the heads of the tribes, the chief of the fathers of the children of Israel, unto Jerusalem, to bring up the **ark** of the covenant of the LORD out of the city of David, which is Zion. 2 Chronicles 5:2

And all the elders of Israel came; and the Levites took up the ark. 2 Chronicles 5:4

And they brought up the <u>ark</u>, and the tabernacle of the congregation, and all the holy vessels that were in the tabernacle, these did the priests and the Levites bring up. 2 Chronicles 5:5

Also king Solomon, and all the congregation of Israel that were assembled unto him before the <u>ark</u>, sacrificed sheep and oxen, which could not be told nor numbered for multitude. 2 Chronicles 5:6

And the priests brought in the <u>ark</u> of the covenant of the LORD unto his place, to the oracle of the house, into the most holy place, even under the wings of the cherubims: 2 Chronicles 5:7

For the cherubims spread forth their wings over the place of the <u>ark</u>, and the cherubims covered the <u>ark</u> and the staves thereof above. 2 Chronicles 5:8

And they drew out the staves of the <u>ark</u>, that the ends of the staves were seen from the <u>ark</u> before the oracle; but they were not seen without. And there it is unto this day. 2 Chronicles 5:9

There was nothing in the <u>ark</u> save the two tables which Moses put therein at Horeb, when the LORD made a covenant with the children of Israel, when they came out of Egypt. 2 Chronicles 5:10

And in it have I put the <u>ark</u>, wherein is the covenant of the LORD, that he made with the children of Israel. 2 Chronicles 6:11 Now therefore arise, O LORD God, into thy resting place, thou, and the <u>ark</u> of thy strength: let thy priests, O LORD God, be clothed with salvation, and let thy saints rejoice in goodness. 2 Chronicles 6:41

And Solomon brought up the daughter of Pharaoh out of the city of David unto the house that he had built for her: for he said, My wife shall not dwell in the house of David king of Israel, because the places are holy, whereunto the <u>ark</u> of the LORD hath come. 2 Chronicles 8:11

And said unto the Levites that taught all Israel, which were holy unto the LORD, Put the holy <u>ark</u> in the house which Solomon the son of David king of Israel did build; it shall not be a burden upon your shoulders: serve now the LORD your God, and his people Israel, 2 Chronicles 35:3

Arise, O LORD, into thy rest; thou, and the ark of thy strength. Psalms 132:8

And it shall come to pass, when ye be multiplied and increased in the land, in those days, saith the LORD, they shall say no more, The <u>ark</u> of the covenant of the LORD: neither shall it come to mind: neither shall they remember it; neither shall they visit it; neither shall that be done any more. Jeremiah 3:16

Which had the golden censer, and the <u>ark</u> of the covenant overlaid round about with gold, wherein was the golden pot that had manna, and Aaron's rod that budded, and the tables of the covenant; Hebrews 9:4

And the temple of God was opened in heaven, and there was seen in his temple the <u>ark</u> of his testament: and there were lightnings, and voices, and thunderings, and an earthquake, and great hail. Revelation 11:19

Two Tables Of Stone

And the LORD said unto Moses, Come up to me into the mount, and be there: and I will give thee <u>tables</u> of stone, and a law, and commandments which I have written; that thou mayest teach them. Exodus 24:12

And he gave unto Moses, when he had made an end of communing with him upon mount Sinai, two <u>tables</u> of testimony, <u>tables</u> of stone, written with the finger of God. Exodus 31:18

And Moses turned, and went down from the mount, and the two <u>tables</u> of the testimony were in his hand: the <u>tables</u> were written on both their sides; on the one side and on the other were they written. Exodus 32:15

And the tables were the work of God, and the writing was the writing of God, graven upon the tables. Exodus 32:16

And it came to pass, as soon as he came nigh unto the camp, that he saw the calf, and the dancing: and Moses' anger waxed hot, and he cast the **tables** out of his hands, and brake them beneath the mount. Exodus 32:19

And the LORD said unto Moses, Hew thee two <u>tables</u> of stone like unto the first: and I will write upon these <u>tables</u> the words that were in the first <u>tables</u>, which thou brakest. Exodus 34:1

And he hewed two <u>tables</u> of stone like unto the first; and Moses rose up early in the morning, and went up unto mount Sinai, as the LORD had commanded him, and took in his hand the two **tables** of stone. Exodus 34:4

And he was there with the LORD forty days and forty nights; he did neither eat bread, nor drink water. And he wrote upon the <u>tables</u> the words of the covenant, the ten commandments. Exodus 34:28

And it came to pass, when Moses came down from mount Sinai with the two <u>tables</u> of testimony in Moses' hand, when he came down from the mount, that Moses wist not that the skin of his face shone while he talked with him. Exodus 34:29

And he declared unto you his covenant, which he commanded you to perform, even ten commandments; and he wrote them upon two **tables** of stone. Deuteronomy 4:13

These words the LORD spake unto all your assembly in the mount out of the midst of the fire, of the cloud, and of the thick darkness, with a great voice: and he added no more. And he wrote them in two **tables** of stone, and delivered them unto me. Deuteronomy 5:22

When I was gone up into the mount to receive the <u>tables</u> of stone, even the <u>tables</u> of the covenant which the LORD made with you, then I abode in the mount forty days and forty nights, I neither did eat bread nor drink water: Deuteronomy 9:9

And the LORD delivered unto me two <u>tables</u> of stone written with the finger of God; and on them was written according to all the words, which the LORD spake with you in the mount out of the midst of the fire in the day of the assembly. Deuteronomy 9:10 And it came to pass at the end of forty days and forty nights, that the LORD gave me the two <u>tables</u> of stone, even the <u>tables</u> of the covenant. Deuteronomy 9:11

So I turned and came down from the mount, and the mount burned with fire: and the two <u>tables</u> of the covenant were in my two hands. Deuteronomy 9:15

And I took the two tables, and cast them out of my two hands, and brake them before your eyes. Deuteronomy 9:17

At that time the LORD said unto me, Hew thee two <u>tables</u> of stone like unto the first, and come up unto me into the mount, and make thee an ark of wood. Deuteronomy 10:1

And I will write on the \underline{tables} the words that were in the first \underline{tables} which thou brakest, and thou shalt put them in the ark. Deuteronomy 10:2

And I made an ark of shittim wood, and hewed two <u>tables</u> of stone like unto the first, and went up into the mount, having the two <u>tables</u> in mine hand. Deuteronomy 10:3

And he wrote on the <u>tables</u>, according to the first writing, the ten commandments, which the LORD spake unto you in the mount out of the midst of the fire in the day of the assembly: and the LORD gave them unto me. Deuteronomy 10:4

And I turned myself and came down from the mount, and put the <u>tables</u> in the ark which I had made; and there they be, as the LORD commanded me. Deuteronomy 10:5

There was nothing in the ark save the two <u>tables</u> of stone, which Moses put there at Horeb, when the LORD made a covenant with the children of Israel, when they came out of the land of Egypt. 1 Kings 8:9

And by weight he gave gold for the <u>tables</u> of showbread, for every table; and likewise silver for the <u>tables</u> of silver: 1 Chronicles 28:16

He made also ten <u>tables</u>, and placed them in the temple, five on the right side, and five on the left. And he made an hundred basins of gold. 2 Chronicles 4:8

And Solomon made all the vessels that were for the house of God, the golden altar also, and the <u>tables</u> whereon the showbread was set; 2 Chronicles 4:19

There was nothing in the ark save the two <u>tables</u> which Moses put therein at Horeb, when the LORD made a covenant with the children of Israel, when they came out of Egypt. 2 Chronicles 5:10

Which had the golden censer, and the ark of the covenant overlaid round about with gold, wherein was the golden pot that had manna, and Aaron's rod that budded, and the **tables** of the covenant; Hebrews 9:4
